DIRECTIONS TO CLINTON STATE PARK

Daily park permits purchased at the front gate for \$4.20 per day.

For I-70 Drivers - Take I-70 (East from Topeka, West from Kansas City), exit at Lecompton, turn South, this is Highway 10. Take this to the Clinton Parkway Exit, at the stop sign, turn right. At the next stop sign, turn right again, then take your 2nd left into Clinton State Park. Stop at the permit station and follow signs to the field.

From Host Hotel - South on McDonald Drive. Take US-59 S ramp. Slight right onto S Iowa St/US-59. Slight right onto Clinton Parkway. Stay on Clinton Parkway until it dead ends. Turn right. Then take your 2nd left into Clinton State Park. Stop at the permit station and follow signs to the field.

ELIGIBILITY

Only purebred Borzoi may be entered. All Borzoi must be one (1) year of age or older on the day of the official race meet to be entered. All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC, CKC, or an AKC or CKC recognized foreign registry. Borzoi registered with the AKC under Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or CKC equivalent may also be entered. Borzoi qualified for National Oval Track Racing Association (NOTRA) meets are considered already qualified for LGRA. The person entering a Borzoi for racing must be the actual owner, or agent of the owner, or be in possession of papers transferring said ownership to person entering the Borzoi. **Spayed/neutered Borzoi may compete.**

ATTENTION!

The Race Committee may dismiss ANY PERSON from the race meet for infractions of the rules, interference (verbal or physical) during the running of any race, or interference with an Official. Entry fees will be forfeited and the individual may be disciplined by BCOA and/or LGRA.

Incomplete, unsigned, conditional or late entries will not be accepted. Entry fees shall be forfeited if a Borzoi is not present at Roll Call. Entry fees shall be forfeited if a Borzoi is disqualified, dismissed or scratched from racing for cause except the following: 1) Bitches in season, which come in after entry is made, shall have their fees refunded; and 2) Borzoi which are determined to be lame, obviously sick, or in season by the Inspection Committee prior to completing any races shall be barred from racing and have their entry fees refunded.

No Substitutions for lame or in season entries.

All hounds entered must be registered with LGRA. Registration is accomplished by sending a copy of the individual registration papers (previously described) with a fee of \$2.00 U.S. at least two weeks prior to the race meet to: LGRA, Dawn Hall, LGRA Registrar-Recorder, 900 S. East St., Weeping Water, NE 68463-4430, (402) 210-2125 - newfs4me@gmail.com. The dog may be registered on the day of the meet by submitting the above requirements to the Race Meet Secretary. LGRA registration is for the life of the dog.

ALL FIRST TIME ENTERED MUST HAVE A QUALIFYING RUN WITH ANOTHER BORZOI BEFORE THE RACE MEET. If Borzoi is not registered with LGRA, please bring individual registration papers for each dog.

ALL RACERS MUST WEAR RACING MUZZLES!

Racers must wear their muzzles from the paddock area to the start. Muzzles may be either Greyhound racing muzzles, plastic-coated English racing muzzles or plastic Greyhound turnout muzzles. Muzzles made of heavy wire are dangerous and are NOT PERMITTED. Light wire muzzles of the English type if not plastic coated, are NOT PERMITTED. A few racing muzzles and racing jackets will be available for use. Muzzles provided may not fit all Borzoi. To insure proper fit of muzzles, please bring your own.

All First Time Entered (FTE) starters will start as Grade D racers unless said racer has an appropriate NOTRA record.

Racing jackets are: white # 1 on Red blanket, white #2 on Blue blanket, black #3 on White blanket, white #4 on Green blanket.

A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for any dog loose on the field which interferes with the running of a race.

Risk & Responsibility – The owner or agent entering a Borzoi in a LGRA meet assumes all risk and responsibility for loss or injury suffered or caused by his/her Borzoi while on the grounds or near the entrance of the race meet. Owners/ Handlers at LGRA events accept and agree to abide by the rules, and generally accepted rules of conduct of good sportsmanship. Further, they shall pick up after their dog, keep the grounds clean, and treat their hounds with respect and in a humane manner.
