The name of the proposed corporation is Borzoi Club of America.

The purposes of the proposed corporation shall be:

- (a) To encourage and promote the breeding of pure-bred Borzoi and to do all possible to bring their natural qualities to perfection;
- (b) To urge members and breeders to accept the standard of the American Kennel Club as the only standard of excellence for which the Borzoi shall be judged;
- (c) To do all in its power to protect and advance the interests of the breed by encouraging sportsmanlike competition at dog shows;
- (d) To conduct licensed and supervised specialty shows under the rules of the American Kennel Club and to perform its functions as Parent Club of the Breed.

It is a corporation which does not contemplate any pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise, to its members.

The Articles of Incorporation of the proposed corporation have been filed on No. 251, January Term, 1964, in the Office of the Prothonotary of Dauphin County.
