
DIRECTIONS TO WATERFORD BEACH PARK

(Site is adjacent to the Eugene O'Neill Theater Center)

From New York or New Haven: RT 95 North to Exit 75 (Waterford 1-A). Follow approximately 3-4 miles, passing a cemetery and Waterford Post Office on right. Turn RIGHT at light onto Avery Lane (Silva's Package store on right just before the light.) At next light go STRAIGHT onto Great Neck Road which is also Route 213. Follow 3 miles to STOP sign. Turn RIGHT – continuing on Great Neck Road ¼ mile. At STOP sign turn RIGHT onto O'Neill grounds.

From Crowne Plaza (Host Hotel), Boston or Providence: RT 95 South to Exit 81 (Cross Road). Turn LEFT at bottom of short ramp – pass Walmart and shopping center on right. At light turn LEFT onto Cross Road. Follow to junction 1-A (bottom of hill). Turn LEFT onto Route 1-A. Approximately 2.5 miles turn RIGHT onto Avery Lane (Silva's Package store on right just before the light.) At next light go STRAIGHT onto Great Neck Road which is also Route 213. Follow 3 miles to STOP sign. Turn RIGHT – continuing on Great Neck Road ¼ mile. At STOP sign turn RIGHT onto O'Neill grounds.

From Hartford and North: Route 2 South to Route 11 from Hartford follow signs to New London – Route 11. At the end of Route 11 turn LEFT at bottom of ramp. At first light (Salem Four Corners) turn RIGHT onto Route 85 toward New London. After passing the Oakdell Motel on the left you will come onto a set of lights. Turn RIGHT at the lights onto Cross Road. Follow to junction with Route 1-A (bottom of hill). Turn LEFT onto Route 1-A. Approximately 2.5 miles turn RIGHT onto Avery Lane (Silva's Package store on right just before the light.) At next light go STRAIGHT onto Great Neck Road which is also Route 213. Follow 3 miles to STOP sign. Turn RIGHT – continuing on Great Neck Road ¼ mile. At STOP sign turn RIGHT onto O'Neill grounds.

ELIGIBILITY

Only purebred Borzoi may be entered. All entries that are one year of age or older and have been registered with the AKC or part of an AKC-registered litter, or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP), are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and trials. Breed disqualifications apply. Spayed or neutered Borzoi may compete.

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACKNOWLEDGED BY MAIL

Incomplete, unsigned, conditional or late entries will not be accepted.

TEST OFFERED

Junior Courser (JC) - Two Tests Offered: Open to all eligible Borzoi. A hound running alone shall receive a certificate from a judge on one date, and a second certification from a different judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed a 600 yard course with a minimum of four (4) turns. Hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. The two runs can be run on the same date at or in conjunction with a National Breed Specialty

A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any hound loose on the field not competing in the course in progress.

A battery operated, continuous loop lure machine, with backup equipment, will be used. Lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips.

BCOA reserves the right to alter the course plan if required by weather and/or field conditions prior to or on the day of the trial, which may affect the usability of the field. Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee, will forfeit entry fee(s), and may be disciplined by the AKC.

750 yards, reversed for Test #2
