Borzoi Club of America Junior Showman 2009 Spotlight

Featuring Cassandra "Cassey" Ceden

Who encouraged your interest in showing dogs in juniors?

My grandmother Dee Burkholder introduced to me to dog showing when I was 6½ years old. I wasn't really old enough yet for juniors, so until I was 9 years old I showed my grandmother's dogs in the puppy classes.

At what age did you start showing dogs?

I started showing dogs at the age of 6½ years. My first time, I was in the ring with my grandmother's dog named "Tag". He was a very big dog and I was barely tall enough to see over him. The judge loved my dog and me and decided to give me Winners Dog over my grandmother and other handlers. My grandmother was very happy that for my first time in the ring I won!

Why do you like showing a Borzoi versus a different breed of dog?

I have grown up with Borzoi all my life. I used to have Rottweilers but Borzoi are more elegant dogs and don't bark and will be so loving. In the ring they are a more laid back kind of dog. They don't require the constant drool rag like a Great Dane and they also don't require the constant hyper dog craziness like sporting and German Shepherd dogs. I have shown those breeds before and while not so bad, Borzoi are just my breed to show.

Do you participate in any other dog-related showing or sports?

I really do not at the moment. I mainly campaign my borzoi bitch "Indi" but she does listen very well—when she wants to be a good girl—and hopefully put that to the test in obedience. Another activity I would love to try is rally. I think Indi and I would make a really good team. I can tell that it is something that Indi would love to do. If she wants to do it, I am all for it. It's always good to try new things and experience other activities. It would also help Indi get new experience because that way she would not get bored of the same activities.

What are your goals in showing dogs?

I actually have many goals in showing dogs. It is not the usual win Best in Show and make my dog top 5 in the country and become a professional handler. Even though

I would love to win a Best in Show several times and even at the Garden. Just winning a Best of Breed at the Garden would make me happy. I can see myself in the future being a professional handler. I love to show dogs. It is my life. Dogs are my life. Most of the time I would rather be with my bitch Indi than be doing anything else but I really want to change how dog shows work. There are all these top handlers that take a dog in and just because they are these big time handlers, they win with that dog. Sometimes that dog is correct to the standard and then there are some dogs that are not what the breed is. Then there are newcomers at the shows that do have a dog that is correct to the standard and are losing to a dog that is not correct, when really they are just losing to the han-



dlers. Many newcomers become discouraged and lose interest in the sport. When there are no newcomers in this sport, who do we have to further dog showing in the future? It hurts to see dogs that are in the ring that you can visibly see faults like lameness. It just makes me think how could you put that dog in that much pain. Animals are just like humans except they walk on four feet and have hair. So why would you put the dog through pain when if you were in that situation. Would you want to be forced to do something when you're in pain?

Another goal I have for dog showing is to change how dogs are entered into the dog show. I believe that there can be a stop to having dogs that are not the standard be put into the ring and win against a dog that is better quality than the other. No dog is perfect, just like no human is perfect but there are dogs that have less faults. To solve this a

test before they are ready to be put into the ring can be issued. Borzoi are suppose to be fast and be able to run long distances. Borzoi were bred to chase down wolves in Russia. They never killed the wolf they only injured the wolf enough to the point that their owner could handle the wolf. The test could prove if the Borzoi can do what it was bred to do. The sad thing is that people that come to dog shows just to watch and see what dogs are winning are not always getting the correct information. Sometimes they are seeing a dog that is not a good specimen of the Breed and thinking that dog is the best. It is sad that we are showing people that that is a good representation of the Breed.

Do you have any advice for newcomers showing or thinking of showing in juniors?

I personally do not show in juniors. I show more in the breed ring. I feel that it is more exciting than juniors but Junior Showmanship is a learning experience. I do recommend to people that are just coming into this sport to go for juniors and get the experience of showing dogs. You make great friends in juniors and you see different breeds and learn ways to show them. For newcomers that are coming into the ring, have patience. You will get frustrated. I have been there but I am still doing dog shows now. I found the best way to learn how to show better is to watch the handlers that have been doing this for a while now. Another piece of advice I give to newcomers is to always pay attention to the judges. Always listen to the directions the judge gives you. It is very important.

What has been your most memorable moment in showing in juniors?

My most memorable moment would be my first time showing in juniors in the Open Senior Class for the first time. I was so nervous and Indi was acting bad that day. She was very fascinated with the little Chinese Crested. I also had 5 other Open Seniors to compete against. I never expected to win and I did win. I went back in for Best Junior Handler and I was up against my friend Morgan that was an Open Intermediate. The judge then awarded me Best Junior Handler. Then following that I won Best of Breed and a Group 4.

If you could recommend or suggest anything to junior judges, what would that be?
