

The Borzoi Arrhythmia Project - Phase I

A Summary of Current Findings

Submitted by Nancy Hopkins

Submissions

To date, 42 people have submitted Holter reports on their Borzoi for a total of 175 individual Borzoi. Several people have submitted Holter results for multiple dogs with the greatest being information on 19 individual dogs submitted by a single person. Several dogs have had Holter tests multiple times with two dogs being tested 5 times, Seven dogs tested 4 times, four dogs tested 3 times, and 27 dogs tested twice. Total submissions = 239.

These tests represent a significant commitment by these participating individuals, especially the people who have Holtered dogs more than once. These data showing the dogs' rhythm over time has been valuable.

A number of people have had the fortitude to Holter puppies. Again, this has been valuable, but we do need to have more puppies Holtered and then followed with subsequent Holters. Ten puppies were Holtered at 7 months, 4 at 8 months, 7 at 9 months, and 4 at 10 months. Anyone who has tried to keep puppies from tearing things up (especially things wrapped around the puppy) for 24 hours can appreciate the dedication shown by these stalwart individuals.

The reason why multiple Holters are important is two fold. First, it has become very obvious that the pathological rhythms that cause sudden death occur sporadically. This type of irregular presentation of arrhythmias is not unusual, but it does make identifying their presence quite a challenge. Depending on when these arrhythmias occur and what triggers them it could be hard to catch the arrhythmia even on a 24 hour Holter. Second, it is important to see how the arrhythmias change over time. Are there more or less as the dog gets older? Is there a time when the arrhythmias seem to peak then go away? Answers to these questions would be important to help researchers understand the nature of Borzoi arrhythmias. Unfortunately we have not had enough dogs tested at regular intervals from puppyhood through adulthood to provide a clear and definitive picture of what is going on, just suggestions of possibilities from the data we do have.

Holter Data – Basic Parameters

When a Holter is done, there are multiple parameters that are measured and recorded. These are a few of the parameters measured.

There was quite a range for Mean Heart Rate across dogs. Just as with people, there are a lot of things that can influence Mean Heart Rate such as health, fitness, and how much running around the dog might have been doing during the Holter test.

Again, the Total Beats is influenced by the Mean Heart Rate and the length of the Holter Exam. Not every Holter test has 24 hours of useful recording. Artifacts and loose leads can cut down on time, as can removing the Holter early due to outside considerations.

Again, as with humans, the fitness of the dog and what the dog is doing will influence these rates. What is also interesting is the percentage of sinus tachycardia beats and sinus bradycardia beats within the 24 hour recording. On average Borzoi have 1.3% sinus tachycardia beats and 28.8% sinus bradycardia beats during a Holter exam.

It is important to understand that the terms sinus rhythm, sinus arrhythmia, sinus tachycardia, and sinus bradycardia are all referring to normal cardiac functional rhythms. Normal cardiac rhythm (known as sinus rhythm) can include periods of rapid heart rates (sinus tachycardia) and very slow heart rates (sinus bradycardia). When you listen to a normal human heart, that steady beat is the sinus rhythm, and is what you are most likely to hear if you listen to your dog's heart. In some cases, you may hear a beat that slows and speeds up as your dog breathes, especially if they are relaxed or at rest. This is a sinus arrhythmia. Sinus arrhythmia can be a normal cardiac rhythm for dogs and is not usually a cause for alarm. It is generally caused by increased pressure on the vagus nerve, which controls heart rate, as a dog breaths in and lowered pressure as the dog breathes out.

Tachycardia means a rapid heart rate. Sinus tachycardia is a heart rate that increases due to normal responses to physical exertion, stress, or pain. Bradycardia is a slow heart rate. Sinus bradycardia is the normal slow heart rate your dog has when sleeping, and is more pronounced in some sighthounds, possibly due to to their high athleticism. In some cases, tachycardia or bradycardia can be a sign of disease, This is called an arrhythmia, and is discussed further below.

Pauses

The Holter report will record pauses that are greater than 5 seconds. According to one source, pauses from 4-6 seconds while the dog is at rest is considered to be a normal finding. We have not seen too many Holtered Borzoi with pauses greater than 5 seconds (only 5 Borzoi out of 175). However, should you see a pause during a time when the dog was engaged in any kind of activity, this warrants further evaluation by a cardiologist.

Interestingly, with the exception of one dog with 2 pauses, the other four Borzoi with pauses came from families with known sudden death (1st degree family members). It is hard to tell if this is just an aberration of the numbers we have so far, or if it is an indication of something more meaningful.

Arrhythmias

There are two kinds of arrhythmias that are recorded; Ventricular ectopy (ectopy means a misplaced beat) and supraventricular ectopy. In order to understand ectopy, you need to understand how the heart beats normally. In a normal rhythm (a sinus rhythm), the electrical impulse that stimulates the heart muscles begins in the atria (which are the smaller chambers on top of the heart), stimulating them to contract first, and then travels down to the ventricles (the larger, more muscular chambers in the lower part of the heart) which contract shortly after the atria.

Ventricular ectopy means that a mis-timed beat originated in the ventricle, rather than atria. Similarly, superventrical ectopy means that the abnormal beat originated in the atrium at a time or location which was abnormal.

Ventricular Ectopy

Ventricular ectopic beats can go by a wide variety of names: Extrasystoles, ventricular premature complexes (VPCs), premature ventricular complexes (PVCs), or premature ventricular beats (PVBs). These beats are earlier than expected based on measurements of the intervals between preceding beats (the R-R interval).



As is obvious from the above numbers, we are finding PVCs in Borzoi. But what is normal? Basically, what is normal depends on the breed of dog. Mark A. Oyama, Marc S. Kraus, and Anna R. Gelzer in their book Rapid Review of ECG Interpretation in Small Animal Practice, Second Edition, provide some insights. For 24-hour Holter monitoring they state that it is normal for Beagles to have fewer than 9 PVC's. For large breed dogs, normal ranges from 0 to 24 VPCs in 24 hours. Salukis tend to have few—0 to 4 VPCs in 24 hours. Whereas for Doberman Pinschers, less than 50 VPCs is considered normal and in Boxers fewer than 91 is considered normal. Notice that in breeds with a high incidence of cardiac disease, Dobies and Boxers, the number of PVC's considered normal is much higher than in the other breeds listed.

Further information on the Doberman is provided by the European Society of Veterinary Cardiology (ESVC). The ESVC has produced screening guidelines for Dilated Cardiomyopathy in Doberman Pinschers. This source states that while less than 50 PVC's is considered normal for this breed any ectopic beats should be concerning. The reason for this concern should be obvious when one looks at the normal ranges found in breeds with low incidence of cardiac disease. Further, in a study KM Meurs, AW Spier, RL Hamlin, and NA Wright concluded that healthy dogs have infrequent PVC's (median 2 in 24 hours) and further suggest that "numerous or sequential VPC" should be investigated as it could be a signal of systemic or cardiac disease.

So is the Borzoi more like the Doberman Pinscher with higher numbers of VPCs or more like the Saluki, with a normal range of VPCs in 24 hours that can be counted on one hand? Lets look at a more detailed breakdown of the numbers of VPCs in Borzois.



The chart on the previous page shows that out of 239 Holters, 70 had 1-5 VPCs. When we add the 58 Holters with no VPCs, the number of Borzoi who had 0-5 VPCs is 128. That is approximately 54% of the Holter tests. One thing to remember is that some of these tests were on dogs with repeated Holters and not all of their results fell within the 0-5 VPC range. The number of Borzois with more than 5 VPCs drops off dramatically with a slight uptick at the 50 - 100 (9) and 101-200 ranges (10).

When looking at this information, it is less important to think of what is normal—since we do not yet know what "normal" is for a Borzoi—than it is to think of severity. Basically, the more PVC's there are in a 24 hour period, the greater the severity of the arrhythmia.

In Dobermans, using the ESVC guidelines, more than 300 VPCs in 24 hours or two Holter tests within a year that have between 50-300 VPCs in 24 hours is diagnostic for occult Doberman DCM no matter what is found (or not found) on an echocardiogram. There are 9 Borzoi with Holter tests with >300 PVC's. There were 30 Borzoi who had 51-299 VPCs in a 24 hour period.

Until we learn otherwise, the guidelines we have adopted to use when counseling owners about when to seek a cardiologist's opinion is what is known as the Large Breed Guidelines. The Large Breed Guidelines, as with the Doberman guidelines state that less than 50 single VPCs is normal. Fewer than 50 single PVC's, while we cannot call it normal in Borzoi, is not a number that requires a cardiologist's consultation unless otherwise desired by the owner. However, when making your decisions about your dog, keep in mind where the majority of Borzoi fall in the curve above, the 0-10 VPC per 24 hour range.

In light of the variety of VPCs on a 24 hour Holter that are considered to be normal in different breeds, it is currently not recommended that anyone advertise that their dog had a "normal" Holter. We do not yet know what a normal Holter for a Borzoi is. It is better to state the number of VPCs found and the complexities of those VPCs when talking about your dog's results.

VPC Complexity

Ventricular ectopy can occur as single premature beats, paired ectopic beats (couplets or pairs), in groups of threes (triplets), or in bursts of 4 or more (runs or salvos) [sometimes runs are defined as 3 or more sequential VPCs; I have seen it both ways on the Holter reports]. There is also Bigeminy and Trigeminy which are rhythmic arrhythmias (Every other beat is premature in Bigeminy and every third beat is premature in Trigeminy). I have only seen one case of Bigeminy mentioned on any Holter and that was noted only on one of the strips and not in the summary itself.

Singles are by far the most common form of premature ventricular beat we see. When looking only at those Borzoi Holters with arrhythmias, the average number of singles is 111 in a 24-hour period. The maximum singles found in one Borzoi was 6,784. Singles are not only the most common, but also the more benign of the different types of VPC complexity. Single ectopic beats scattered throughout the day will do little if anything to compromise the dog. The large breed guidelines specify that 100-2,000 VPCs is a mild increase. Mild or not, something is going on to cause the increase in VPCs; in the case of Borzoi, we do not know yet if this rise in VPC numbers could indicate a channelopathy, some form of cardiomyopathy, or another pathology such as subaortic stenosis. Remember the ESVC guidelines for Doberman Holters - 300 or more VPCs in 24 hours is diagnostic for occult Doberman DCM. Borzoi with elevated PVC numbers, even if only singles, should get an echo at the very least and be watched for developing DCM as the occult phase of the disease can be fairly prolonged and may not immediately show up on an echo. Arrhythmias can also be found in dogs with systemic disease and some medical problems, so a wellness visit to the vet is recommended.

When thinking about VPC complexity it may be helpful to think in terms of the Lown Grading System. This grading system should be used with caution as it was developed for people with cardiac disease, it was not developed for dogs. The Lown Grading System attempts to define the parameters on a Holter or ECG that increase the risk of ventricular tachycardia or ventricular fibrillation.

Lown Grading System

Grade	Feature
Grade 0	No PVC's
Grade 1	Occasional unifocal PVC's (less than 30 per hour (or <720 per 24 hour period)) (Unifocal = coming from one site in the heart)
Grade 2	Frequent unifocal PVC's (more than 30 per hour (or >720 per 24 hour period))
Grade 3	Polymorphic (also known as multifocal or multiform) PVC's (Polymorphic = having several forms, this occurs when the source of the PVCs is coming from multiple places in the heart)
Grade 4a	pairs
Grade 4b	triplets or non sustained runs of monomorphic ventricular tachycardia (Also seen in some sources as Salvos which are 4-6 PVC's in a row)
Grade 5	R-on-T Phenomenon

Considering these different complexities, what was found in Borzoi? There were 77 Holters that showed at least one pair and 25 that showed either a triplet or a run of more than 3 beats. R-on-T was seen in one dog through two Holter tests. This dog was diagnosed with Dilated Cardiomyopathy. The R-on-T phenomenon finding caused the cardiologist to add another drug to help better control the Borzoi's arrhythmias.

Why are pairs, triplets, runs and R-on-T so concerning? First, let me make the point that all pairs, triplets and runs are not as concerning for the well-being of the dog as others. None of them are good and ideally you would not see them on your dog's Holter report, but if these groupings of PVC's occur at a slow rate of speed, then they are not as concerning as if they are "tight" or occur in quick succession. This is one reason why, on the Holter report, they give the rate of the fastest run. The faster and longer the run of tachycardia, the more the concern level rises. Even if sustained (lasting longer than 30 seconds) ventricular tachycardia does not degenerate into ventricular fibrillation, this abnormal heart rate is dangerous because if it is fast enough, it can reduce the amount of blood that the heart is able to pump to the body and brain. This is quite different than the sinus tachycardia that occurs when a dog is running. This type of normal tachycardia has distinct characteristics that differentiate it from the more malignant run of tachycardia that is not normal and did not occur because the dog was running or excited. However, listing your dog's activities and times of the activities along with the start and end times of the Holter recording, then sending that to your cardiologist, can help them with some of the nuances when interpreting your dog's Holter report.

That being said, we have a dog who had a history of a few pairs and runs that were slow and not particularly concerning. This dog later dropped dead. We also have a series of Holters on a dog who had pairs that were not very close, so were not particularly concerning. Then on a recent Holter there was a very close pair. So pairs and runs should get your attention whether or not they are fast. They indicate that something is going on in the heart that is not right.

The R-on-T Phenomenon is a bit different than the other types of PVC complexity. R-on-T is a single PVC that just happens to occur at a dangerous place in the cardiac cycle. Because of where the PVC is placed, it has the potential of sending the heart into ventricular fibrillation which is what causes sudden cardiac death. Any dog with R-on-T Phenomenon, no matter how many instances that are recorded, should be seen by a cardiologist as soon as possible. This is true for dogs with prolonged fast runs as well.

Another way to look at Holter results is a set of screening criteria that Dr. Meurs proposed for screening asymptomatic Boxers for Arrhythmogenic Right Ventricular Cardiomyopathy. These recommendations were based on severity of the findings, not based on studies to determine the predictive value of the findings for future development of ARVC.

Dr. Meurs' Proposed	Screening (Criteria for	Asym	ptomatic Boxers

4	300-1000 single VPC's over 24 hours or 100-300 VPC's over 24 hours with increasing complexity (frequent couplets, triplets, and ventricular tachycardia (runs))	Affected - may consider treatment
5	Greater than 1000 VPC's over 24 hours	Affected - may consider treatment

Again, caution should be used when thinking about the criteria above if for no other reason than it was tailored for another breed with more than likely a different inherited cardiac issue. However, both the Lown Grading Scheme and Dr. Meurs' proposed grading criteria for Boxers are useful to help you understand the levels of increasing risk for cardiac disease in your dog when you receive a Holter report. This will assist you in determining if you need to seek a cardiologist's interpretation or get an echo on your dog if that is warranted. The Lown Grading System is very good at helping you understand the relative risk the different types of VPCs may cause. Bottom line, the more VPCs your dog has, the greater the risk of heart disease or sudden death. The more complexity of those VPCs, the risk for cardiac disease and sudden death go up.

Dr. Meurs' comments about keeping the dog out of the breeding program for one year until more testing could be done is an example of a strategy one can utilize when thinking of the utility of the Holter information for your breeding dogs. Other than the recommendations I will make at the end of this article, it is important to remember that at this point in time, NO DOG should be removed from a breeding program based on the Holter results alone. If the Holter results are concerning, then one needs to seek the expertise of a cardiologist and discuss the risks and benefits of keeping the dog in your breeding program. At that point, it is appropriate to make a decision based on your knowledge as a breeder and what is best for your dogs and the breed as a whole.

Supraventricular Ectopy

Ectopic beats that originate above the level of the ventricles appear to be far less common in our breed than ventricular ectopy. There were 193 Holters that showed no supraventricular ectopy at all. There are 46 Holters that show supraventricular ectopy. Of those, the average number of supraventricular ectopic beats is 67. However, this is specifically higher due to the number seen in two dogs; one with 11,991 supraventricular premature beats and another with 1,690. Without these two dogs the average number of supraventricular ectopy is 9.7 in 24 hours. Here is the distribution of supraventricular ectopy found in the Borzois Holtered.





There was also significantly less complexity with the supraventricular ectopy than seen with the ventricular ectopy on the Borzois Holtered. Only two dogs had supraventricular pairs and only one had runs of supraventricular ectopic beats.

This type of arrhythmia is not as concerning for sudden death as ventricular arrhythmias are, but they can cause problems. In some dogs serious runs of supraventricular tachycardia (atrial tachycardia) can cause similar signs as ventricular tachycardia—weakness, exercise intolerance, shortness of breath, and even fainting. Other dogs will appear asymptomatic even with long periods of supraventricular tachycardia.

Remember that the atria are above the level of the ventricles so supraventricular ectopy will include atrial arrhythmias. When atrial arrhythmias occur and happen repeatedly or continuously they can be an indication of a valvular disease or other structural heart disease. This type of ectopy can also be caused by cardiac cancers on the atrium.

There are some giant breed dogs (most notably Irish Wolfhounds) that have atrial fibrillation without any identifiable structural defect in the heart. However, atrial fibrillation in Irish Wolfhounds is often a precursor to dilated cardiomyopathy. In most breeds, atrial fibrillation is a sign of significant cardiac disease. We have one instance of atrial fibrillation in a currently healthy Borzoi. The significance of this finding is unknown at this time.

The significance of supraventricular ectopy is not known in our breed. If you see significant numbers of these misplaced beats in your dog's Holter report it would be prudent to discuss the findings with your vet to determine the need for specialist evaluation.

Conclusions

An important thing to remember is that not all arrhythmias one sees are necessarily due to heart disease. Should your dog show concerning data on its Holter report, it is wise to take the dog to your primary vet for an examination. Arrhythmias can arise from such things as imbalances in electrolytes, metabolic disturbances, splenic masses, sepsis, low blood pressure, low levels of oxygen, thyroid dysfunction, tick-borne disease, gastrointestinal disease, pyometra, renal failure, Addison's disease, adrenal tumors, anemia, and pain.

No decisions should ever be made about breeding based on one screening test, much less a Holter test. It is incumbent upon the breeder to do due diligence to insure that if a dog is removed from a breeding program it is for true need. One cannot make assumptions based on screening tests alone. A true diagnosis requires more extensive testing and consultation with a veterinary specialist. This is especially true when parsing the information one receives from a new test such as the Holter recording. We do not yet have the information needed to differentiate what is truly normal and what is pathologic on a Holter test in a Borzoi. Do not remove a dog from your breeding program based on Holter tests without consulting with a veterinary cardiologist.

That said, if you are concerned about arrhythmias but your dog either does not fall into an area of concern that would send you to speak with a cardiologist, or a cardiologist has told you that they do not suspect a problem that would cause you to remove a dog from the gene pool but you still feel the need to be cautious, then the following advice might be helpful.

Avoid breeding two dogs with higher numbers of VPCs or two dogs with complex VPCs together. Treat very high numbers of VPCs or dogs with VPC complexities with more caution than those with lower numbers. Use the Lown Grading System and the Meurs Proposed Screening Criteria for Asymptomatic Boxers as a guide. Attempt to breed dogs with higher numbers of VPCs only to dogs with low numbers. Be sure to monitor the offspring of any dogs with higher numbers of VPCs or VPC complexity with Holters. We have some documentation that suggests that dogs with littermates that died of sudden death have gone on to produce dogs that succumb to sudden death. So while we do not want breeders to remove dogs from their breeding programs without considerable thought and discussion with a cardiologist, we do advise vigilance.

It is also important to remember that just because your dog has a Holter report with fewer than 50, or even 25 VPCs, this does not mean your dog's Holter was normal because we do not know what normal is yet. I repeat, it is ill advised at this time to claim that a dog has a normal Holter, especially after only one Holter test. There are several reasons for this. First, we do not know what normal is. Second, there is more to Holter interpretation than the summary one receives on the Holter report. Third, there is growing evidence that the arrhythmias that cause sudden death in Borzoi occur sporadically and malignant rhythms may be difficult to catch on one or even multiple Holter tests. Elevated numbers and complexity of VPCs suggest that something may be happening to Borzoi hearts but these findings are nonspecific. So even a Holter report with absolutely no abnormalities does not necessarily mean that the Borzoi is "normal."

Here are a few examples for my caution:

Borzoi 1 - Died of Sudden Death

This dog's sire also died of Sudden Death.

Had Borzoi 1 received only one Holter on 4/17/18 there would have been absolutely no suggestion as to why the dog died of sudden cardiac death. Because of the earlier Holters we know that this Borzoi was having more complex VPCs, though at no time did this Borzoi go beyond the Doberman criteria for "normal" at 50 VPCs in 24 hours.

However on the Lown Grading System this dog would get a Grade 4b. On Dr. Meurs' proposed screening criteria for asymptomatic Boxers, this dog would have gotten a 4 due to the complex VPCs seen on the first two Holters. Always pay attention to the pairs, triplets and runs no matter how few the number of total VPCs.

No dog with any complexities on a Holter test should ever be considered to be normal. The owner of this dog correctly sought the opinion of a cardiologist.

When taken for an exam with a cardiologist, this dog was diagnosed with DCM based on the echo findings. This dog would have been given the Lown Grade of 4a because of the pair. Getting an echo on this dog was the correct precaution even though Borzoi 2's total VPC count was only 21.

Borzoi 3 - Died of Sudden Death

Borzoi 3 is a good example of why one Holter may not be showing you the entire picture when it comes to arrhythmias. It is unknown if another Holter would have provided more information on Borzoi 3, as this is the only Holter on this dog. Just as with Borzoi 1, one Holter may look very normal even though other Holters provide more information. It is also important to know that in some forms of cardiac pathology, the number of arrhythmias may either decrease or increase over time. Just as seen in Borzoi 1, a decrease in the number of arrhythmias does not necessarily indicate a dog will not die of sudden death.

Borzoi 4 - Died of Sudden Death

This Borzoi is an example of why moderate numbers of VPCs should not be ignored. Even though, based on the Large-breed Guidelines, this dog had only a mild level of VPCs, further investigation was needed and was correctly sought by the owners. This dog would have received a Lown grade of 1 but a Meurs' grade of 4 - Affected, due to the number of ectopic ventricular beats. The use of both grading systems can be of use to help breeders determine whether or not they need to seek the opinion of a cardiologist. Further, using the ESCV guidelines for Doberman Pinschers, this dog would have been considered to be Affected with occult Doberman DCM.


Borzoi 5 is another example of how one Holter may not be enough to show you what is really going on. It is also an example of how arrhythmias can change as the status of the heart changes. Just as with OFA Screening cardiac, eye, or thyroid exams, a Holter exam is only a snapshot of the heart rhythm on the day it was recorded. More than one is needed. Because of the Holter test that was done on 9/9/20, this Borzoi was taken for an examination and diagnosed with DCM.

Especially if one is concerned about DCM or Sudden Death in your lines, periodic Holter tests should be done over the life of breeding animals. Data from dogs across their entire lives from puppyhood to old age is very important to the Borzoi Arrhythmia Project as it helps to provide an understanding of how arrhythmias may change over the life of a Borzoi. There are a few breeders who are currently conducting repeated Holters on their dogs and sharing this information with the Borzoi Arrhythmia Project. I encourage anyone else Holtering their dogs to share the results also.

While I know that it is frustrating to have no definitive guidelines to help you breed for better cardiac health in your dogs, please understand we continue to work to find answers for you. Please continue to sent Holter reports for the Borzoi Arrhythmia Project, even if you are using your own Holter or doing testing through a cardiologist. Also, please continue to notify me about any known sudden deaths in Borzoi, as this also adds to our understanding of the problem. I recommend that anyone who is unfortunate enough to have a Borzoi die suddenly contact the Borzoi Health and Welfare Foundation through Danielle Steenkamp immediately and allow the heart of your dog to be sent to Dr. Kathleen Kelly at the Penn State Animal Diagnostics Lab for a detailed necropsy. Every bit of information helps us get another step closer to our goal. §

I. Borzoi Registrations and Show Entries

In 1957, there were 162 Borzoi registered, compared to 151 Borzoi registered in 1956. Borzoi were ranked 66th out of 112 breeds for number of dogs registered. Per an AKC report, there were 436,600 dogs registered in 1957 with 114,400 of those hound breeds (26.2%). Beagles were the number 1 breed with 68,413 registered. Number 3 were Dachshunds with 37,336 registered. In 1957, in all regions, the points for Borzoi were set at the minimum: 2 dogs or 2 bitches for 1 point. 3 dogs or 3 bitches for 2 points. 4 dogs or 4 bitches for 3 points. 5 dogs or 5 bitches for 4 points. 6 dogs or 6 bitches for 5 points. There were 432 all-breed shows, 290 specialties held with all-breed shows (including the 4 Borzoi specialties) and 332 independent specialties. 22% of the shows were benched.

The biggest shows in the country were The International Kennel Club of Chicago with 2121 dogs, Morris & Essex with 2092 dogs, Westminster with 2022 dogs and Harbor Cities (CA) with 1686 dogs. Per a BCOA report, of the 432 shows, 235 shows had no Borzoi, and 62 shows had one Borzoi or one Borzoi of each sex so no points were won. 47 shows had a major in one sex. There were 711 Borzoi entries. California had 235 entries and 20 majors at 38 shows. There were 192 entries and 13 majors at 47 shows in New Jersey, New York and eastern Pennsylvania. The Midwest (Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan, Minnesota, Ohio, Wisconsin) had 158 entries and 6 majors at 47 shows. Oregon and Washington had 47 entries and 5 majors at 16 shows. 15 Borzoi finished their championships in 1957. The big news during 1957 was the development and successful testing of two new vaccines "to conquer" distemper and canine hepatitis.

IV News (club news, litters, Borzoi purchased, wins)

(The BCOA meeting minutes, written by secretary Emma Denton, have been summarized and combined with Emma Denton's comments about the meetings' topics in her AKC Gazette columns)

Borzoi Club of America's board meeting Feb 11, 1957. 40 members had sent in ballots. The 1957 officers elected were president Weldon J McCluskey, first vice-president Clarence R DeCraene, Sr, second vice-president Russell O Everhart, secretary-treasurer Mrs Lawrence (Emma) Denton, delegate to the AKC Chester A Adee, board of governors, Mrs Grace J Dusenbury, Mrs Ray (Terry) DeCraene, Jr, Donald P Knode and Arnold J Brock. There was a complaint received that there were two DeCraenes on the ballot. It was explained that they are not of an "immediate family", as each has his own immediate family and separate Borzoi kennels. A letter was read signed by 10 members (Carla & Dimitri Alioshin, Leland Beecher, Phyllis Johnson, Jacqueline Geer, Lyle & Phydelma Gillette, Bobbye & Clifford Potter, Edythe & Kenneth Schwartz, Anne & Donald Goschke, John Jelatis and Mrs Genevieve V Pitcock) of the Borzoi Club of California, requesting permission to form a separate club in Northern California. The 500-600 mile distance to travel to southern California for club meetings and specialty shows is a hardship, and the AKC won't allow the Borzoi Club of California to alternate the specialty show site between southern and northern California. The board voted to approve their request, so they can apply to the AKC to form the new Borzoi club. Mr Adee presented the draft of the new Constitution and By-Laws, as mailed to the members. Three amendments were made. The board approved, so the changes can be sent to the AKC for approval. Mrs Denton reported that the publication of the new Borzoi book has been delayed, due to the publishing company moving. New members approved: Mrs George H Buckley, Cedar Ridge Farm Pipersville PA, has 6 Borzoi. Mrs John (Harriet) Lindsey, Rolling Meadows Farm Roanoke IN, is the breeder/owner of Ch Boi of Rolling Meadows. Mrs Forrest Griffeth, Studio City CA, owns "Zaldi", Ch Ainaldi Perchinoff, winner of his American Championship by going Best of Breed at three major shows and his Canadian championship in three shows, including two hound groups. Zaldi has appeared in the movies To Catch A Thief with Cary Grant and So This Is Paris with Tony Curtis. Zaldi was bred by the Charles Colstads of Portuguese Bend CA and was sired by Ch Rubles Perchino out of Ch Lady of Bolshoi.

Borzoi Club of America's board meeting April 5, 1957. The Board voted to give a certificate of merit to each Borzoi, owned by a club member for winning a Best In Show, from 1956 and after that. The first Borzoi to be so honored will be Ch Black Falcon of Twin Elms owned by Mrs Nellie Wood Hilsmier of Ft Wayne Indiana, who won BIS at Mattoon IL September 1,

1956. William Woodley was approved as the editor of the BCOA bulletin *The Aristocrat*. Mr Woodley owns a Haljean Borzoi and has been a BCOA member for 2 years. New members approved were: Mr and Mrs Sidney W Cox, Inglewood CA, owners of Ch Yermak's Rurick. Mrs Jean M Goshorn, Blairs Mills PA, owner of her first Borzoi. Mr and Mrs John M Pinette, Claremont NH, owners of Borzoi for 15 years who recently became breeders. Mrs Isabell V Walton, El Monte CA, Llebasi kennels and owner of Ch Llebasi's Rushan Vodka and Ch Golupka of Alpine.

Secretary Emma Denton was authorized to purchase Borzoi pins for new members and to have printed the certificates for new Best In Show winners. There was a discussion about William Woodley's request to increase news in the *Aristocrat*, but to retain the mimeographed form of publication to keep the cost at a minimum. New members approved: Miss Marian Stebbins,

at a minimum. New members approved: Miss Marian Stebbins, Dearfield MA, has one Borzoi, a white and brindle male from the Robinson's litter. Mr A K Robinson, East Orange NJ, owns Sniezhinka of Romanoff. William Shepard & Harry Ferguson, Amelia OH, have shown their first Borzoi, the lemon and white male Victorski O'Stoffran, and have acquired the females Scheherazade's Zareya and Kotlas of Mettler Hobby Farm.

Borzoi Club of America's board meeting and membership meeting Sept. 8, 1957 held after the BCOA specialty show. 20 members present. Approved were the members of the nominating committee, Harriet Crane chairman, Ray DeCraene, and Erma Denton. Mrs Ray (Terry) DeCraene was approved to be chairperson of the Bench Show Committee, along with members Weldon McCluskey and Ray DeCraene. It was approved that the only show results to be published in The Aristocrat would be the BCOA specialty, Westminster and the Morris & Essex Kennel Club. The members wanted the BCOA specialty moved from a fall show to a spring show. The members also presented names of judges that they would like to be the judge, and this list will be a guide for the Bench Show committee to select a judge. It was agreed to turn over the leftover trophies from this year's specialty to the 1958 specialty trophy chairman Ray De Craene. Approved to have wooden placques engraved to present to those members whose dogs won Best In Show, instead of certificates. New members approved were Miss Judith Freehafer, Bryn Mawr PA, who owns Med-O-Land's Sveltana, bred in 1954 by Leslie G Kaufmann, by Nananhals Bistri out of Zanoza of Topau. Judith and her Borzoi went to Rio de Janeiro in August for a six month visit with her family. Since Svetlana was the only Borzoi in Rio, she created a sensation whenever she went. Carlton J Jackson moved from California to Conesur NY. He obtained his first Borzoi of Woronzova bloodlines, nine years ago. Mrs Genevieve V Pitcock Sacramento CA is a member of the board of the newly formed Borzoi Club of Northern California. She owns Yermaks Ekatrina. Mrs Denton reported that the Pinettes from New Hampshire, the Jacksons from the western part of New York state and the Everharts from Michigan traveled the greatest distances of all exhibitors to attend the BCOA specialty. Mrs William H Woodcock, former second vice-president of BCOA, made the trip from her home in San Gabriel CA, to see the specialty. Another member spectator was Benson Sale,

Philadelphia, who recently returned from a tour of duty in Germany with the army, and brought home a German Borzoi.



Borzoi Club of America's board meeting December 1, 1957. Mr Adee presented suggestions from the AKC to the club's revisions of the BCOA Constitution and By-Laws. These changes will be mailed to the members. Bench show committee chairman Mrs Ray DeCraene reported that the AKC approved our request to hold the 1958 specialty May 24, at the Monmouth county all-breed show. Mrs DeCraene requested that for the specialty, the puppy class be divided into 6-9 months and 9-12 months, which the Board approved. The board approved limiting The Aristocrat to 5 pages, and allowed group placings and BIS wins to be published. It was approved to take advantage of Dogs World's offer to obtain a Dog World award for Outstanding Service for Dogs, and that Mrs Denton should send out letters asking the members for nominations. It was approved to offer the same annual awards in 1958, that would be given for wins in 1957. The annual awards had to be approved by the AKC. Here is the letter to the AKC: "The Borzoi Club of America offers to Members only, to be competed for during the year 1958, the following Annual Specials - Sterling Silver Trophy For Best of Breed, Sterling Silver Trophy For Best of Opposite Sex, Sterling Silver Trophy for Best American Bred. Best of Breed Trophy will be awarded to the owner of the Borzoi, dog or bitch, accumulating the greatest number of points (AKC rating) by virtue of being placed Best of Breed or higher. If the dog or bitch awarded Best of Breed is already a champion of record, that dog or bitch will be credited with the number of points it would have been awarded had it been entered in a regular class. Best of Opposite Sex Trophy will be awarded to the owner of the Borzoi, dog or bitch, of opposite sex to the Best of Breed winner, accumulating the greatest number of points (AKC rating) by virtue of Opposite Sex awards only. If the dog or bitch is already a champion of record, it will be credited with the number of points it would have been awarded had it been entered in a regular class. Best America Bred Trophy will be awarded to the owner of the Borzoi, dog or bitch, placing first in the American Bred Class the greatest number of times. In case of a tie, championship points acquired by virtue of these awards during the year, will determine the winner. The above Specials, offered at all shows held under AKC regulations are void if won by dog or bitched owned by non-members."

The winners of the 1957 BCOA Annual Awards were Best of Breed to Ch Yermaks Rurick, owners Mr & Mrs Sidney Cox, Santa Clara CA. Best Opposite Sex to Ch Tatiana of Alpine, owner Mrs G Clifton Potter, Stockton CA. Best American Bred to Nicky The Great of Tamboer, owners Mr & Mrs Leonard Tamboer, Allendale NJ. (These awards were presented at the membership meeting, February 1958.) During 1957, the BCOA Aristocrat was published once by Weldon McCluskey, and twice by William H Woodley and Lena Tamboer. Mrs Denton had the Borzoi column published each month in the AKC Gazette.

Midwest Borzoi Club. Elected for 1957 were President Henry Mackh, Wayne IL; first vice-president Mrs Harriet Lindsay, Roanoke IN; second vice-president R L Smith, Manchester MO;

treasurer Mrs Hillgamyer, East St Louis IL; secretary Mrs Villa Smith, Manchester MO; directors Mrs Mabel Millichip of Holder MO; Mrs Charlotte Machkh of Wayne IL; Major and Mrs Chester J Clark of Glen Arbor MI.

Borzoi Club of California. After the BCOC specialty, there was a dinner at the home of Mr and Mrs Burton Norbury, and a club member meeting. Ballots were counted for officers. 1957 officers elected were: president: Mrs Marge Kelley of North Hollywood CA, vice-president: Miss Dorothy Harris of Escondido CA, secretary-treasurer: Mrs Mae Blanton of Sunland CA, director: Mrs Marion Woodcock of San Gabriel CA, director: Sidney Cox of Inglewood CA. At the BCOC's specialty, three littermates won major awards: Taras Bulba of Suntan, owner James & Elizabeth Forry, and Hasi Murat of Suntan and Malinka Kukla of Suntan both owned by breeders William and Marion Woodcock. Marge Cox, trophy chairman and Art Sweet, bench show committee chairman, were thanked for their hard work in making the specialty a success. Mr Sweet made the benching tops, with the new club crests and name plates. The benches were decorated with gold corrugated paper with purple accents. Above the benching, held high on spears, were purple and gold flags. The club's crests are the result of a contest to choose an emblem. Harold Sundt was the winner, having submitted a simple graceful shield design. Mrs Isabell Walton presented her Llebasi Memorial trophy (formerly called the Volk Memorial trophy) to the black and white Ch Gotchina of Grador owned by Miss Dorothy Harris. This trophy is given on a point system of wins by club members' dogs. New president Mrs Kelley presented an engraved medallion to retiring president Mrs Woodcock in appreciation for her service "during a most trying year of changes" in the club and the serious illness of Mr Woodcock. The following year, the Borzoi Club of California club awarded Mr & Mrs Sidney Cox's Ch Yermak's Rurick (pictured) the Llebasi Memorial Trophy (donated by Isabell Walton), for the most Best of Breed wins during 1957. Ch Yermak's Rurick also won the Club's annual award for outstanding male. The outstanding bitch award, donated by Mr & Mrs James Johnson, went to Mrs G Clifton Potter's Ch Tatiana of Alpine. The Yermak's Polken Memorial Trophy, donated by Dimitri & Carla Alioshin for the best Bred by Exhibitor (dog or bitch) based on number of points earned during the year went to Ch Tatiana of Alpine breeder/owner

Mrs Potter. The Rancho Gabriel Cup donated by Mr & Mrs Lyle Gillette, was won by Ch Yermak's Platon, owned by Don & Anne Goschke. The Cup is won on the point system.

The new club, Borzoi Club of Northern California, got AKC approval, and will hold its first sanctioned match December 15, 1957 in

Sacramento. Elected for 1957 were president Mrs Phydelma Gillette, vice president Don Goschke, secretary-treasurer Mrs Phyllis Johnson.

Littermates Ch Tatyana of Bev-Tra two group 4 and two group 3 and Tasha of Bev-Tra a group 2 and a group 3 from the classes,

then as a Champion a group 2 and a group 4; both girls owned by breeder Beverly Traglio of Oregon. Ch Boi of Rolling Meadows (D) two group 4 and



two group 2, owned by Harriet Lindsay of Indiana. Fleur Des Lance of Malora (D) group 3 owner G L Seifert. Ch Obvorozevat Laska of Alpine (B) group 4, breeder Mrs G C Potter owner Lyle & Phydelma Gillette of California. Ch Dimitri of Vala Rama Farms (D) group 3 owned by Charles Conally of Michigan. Czarina HHF of Gwejon (B) two group 4 owned by John and Gwen Pinette of New Hampshire. Ch Dark Star of Sleeping Bear (D) group 3 owned by Henry Mackl of Illinois. Ch Gotchina of Grador (D) group 3 owned by Dorothy Harris Sweet of California. Ch Vigow of Romanoff III (D), group 4 owned by Leonard and Elizabeth Tamboer of New Jersey. Ch Black Falcon of Twin Elms, a self black male with white trim, owned by Mrs Nellie Wood Hilsmier of Ft Wayne Indiana, and handled by Richard Cooper went BIS July 14, at the Kankakee kennel club all-breed show, judge Alva Rosenberg. Black Falcon also won four group 1, three group 2 and two group 3. Mrs Hilsmier has completed new kennels for her Borzoi with electric heat, air conditioning, individual 50 foot runs, and a 3 acre exercise yard. For the second year, Mrs V M Martinson of New Brunswick Canada had numerous Canadian Best in Show all-breeds wins with her English import, Can Ch Kuban Kuzma. Czarina HHF of Gwejon CD, owned by John Pinette and his wife Gwen who trained and showed Czarina, is the first New England Borzoi to earn a CD. Her scores were 196, 196 ½ and 192. Ch Garsova Ivanova of Alpine is the 9th champion for her dam, Ch Uda Adams, owned by Mrs G C Potter.

Louis Murr has returned from judging an all-breed show in Bogota, Columbia, South America. Colonel and Mrs Stedman Shumway Hanks visited many Borzoi kennels during their recent European trip and had the good fortune to meet and talk with Mrs Artem Boldareff, who now lives in France. Mr & Mrs Artem Boldareff had the Woronzova kennels going back to the 1890s. Balder of Tor, a young white and lemon colored Borzoi bred by Matilda Loutsenhizer, sired by the late Ch Winjones Lebid out of Bur Mar's Mascha of Suntan, was flown from California to New York, and then to Argentina. Major Clark, who has Sleeping Bear Borzoi, Glen Arbor Michigan, is stationed in Korea. Mrs Clark recently joined him taking with her, Ch Nichols of Sleeping Bear, probably the first Borzoi to be in Korea.

Miss Marietta Gregory, Llano CA, died. She will be remembered as the co-owner with Miss Edith Green, of Princess Natacha, the famous Borzoi world's record holder for racing and hurdle jumping. Harvey C. Goodwin's "Nikki" died in September 1957 at the age of 13½ years. Mr Goodwin left him in the care of Mr Woodley when he went to Europe, and Nikki was quite happy in his new home but age took its toll. Bred by the late John L. Hensey (Hensey Hobby Farm) he was sired by Ch Adam's Bolshoi out of Yura of Romanoff, and spent most of his life in the theatrical world as a prominent part of Mr Goodwin's stage career. Ch

Winjones Lebid, an English import owned by Mrs E Edinger of Phoenix, died.

Ch Midtfyn's Boja (pictured), imported from Denmark in 1947, died April 1957. He was sired by Finis Pjotr (Finis Nicolaus x Lavas Micha of Wladislaw Monasterium) out of Hollywood's Lola (Helmarhois Wladimir x Tjaka Romanow), breeder Mrs Marie Barlebo, owners Mr & Mrs Harold Sundt Jr. Bojo sired 3 litters, one in Norway that produced two champions and 2 USA litters. Mrs Potter top producing male Ch Atamen of Alpine was sired by Boja. Boja appears in many California bred dogs' pedigrees. Boja was in fashion shows and in TV programs. He was pictured in



color with Illona Massey in The American Magazine, was on the cover of Colliers in 1950, and on the cover of Parade with one of his daughters. Boja appeared in two movies, The Great Lover with Bob Hope and Rhonda Fleming and Fancy Pants with Bob Hope and Lucille Ball. Ch Gandil, also imported from Denmark by Mr & Mrs Harold Sundt, along with Ch Midtfyn's Boja, died in July, just

three months after Boja. Fortunately, the Sundts have two of their offspring, Sascha and Darsch of Sundra to help fill the void.

Ch Ivanda of Yadasar, an import from England, owner Mary Traviner, earned her Championship undefeated in her sex. She went Best of Breed over specials several times. She won Best Opposite Sex 3 times in her career. Ch Winjones Janda, imported from England by Mary Traviner in 1951, died in April. Janda was the first English bred Borzoi to win Best of Breed at Westminster. He was one of the few self black Borzoi to win the Hound group consistently. He was the top winning Borzoi owned by a BCOA member in 1953. In June, the 13 year old Eng/Am Ch Winjones Balvoniza died. Bred by Mrs Winifred Chadwick of Surrey England, she was imported by Mary Traviner. She was white with sable markings. In England, her post-war record for CCs has only been surpassed by one dog, Eng Ch Melody of Yvill. In the USA Balvonizae won groups from the classes. Mrs Mary M Traviner, Omaha Nebraska, is editing a new independent magazine Riders of the Wind published in England, about Borzoi in the USA and in other countries.

Borzois in the limelight include Marion Woodcock's Hasi Murat of Suntan on the cover of a photo display brochure; Martha Taylor's Ch Walzof Perchinoff adorned with a rhinestone studded black velvet collar parading with beautiful models at a charity style show at the Beverly Hilton hotel; the D'Essen and the Dusenbury Borzoi in frequent TV appearances, among them the Mike Todd Madison Square Garden party; Borzoi on the Patrice Munsell TV show, a lovely grey Borzoi pictured with a proud owner of a new Edsel car in a folder received by Ford Motor company stockholders; and two well groomed Borzoi shown walking beside a spotlessly attired lady was the eye catching

advertisement of a Montclair NJ cleaning establishment.

The New York Herald October 22 issue featured two white Romanoff dogs from Animal Talent Scouts pictured with Katherine Windsor in a black sequin dress in a striking Bonwit-Teller advertisement. Animal Talent Scouts acquired the German dog "Donnaij" from the Howard Andersons of New York. The sable and black masked Borzoi was used in a fashion show at the Starlight Roof at the Waldorf Astoria. He wore a special Cartier collar valued at a million-and-a half dollars, walking with a model wearing a sable coat. They arrived at the hotel in a chauffeured car.

The U.S. 27th Infantry regiment, known as the "Wolfhounds" received a new mascot, a four-month-old Borzoi that will be named Kolchak IV. He is a gift from Lorraine and Bernard D'Essen, of Animal Talent Scouts, Inc, New York City and will be a companion for Kolchak III, the Borzoi presented to the regiment last year from Mrs G Clifton Porter.

Mr and Mrs Kenneth Schwartz purchased two six month old litter brothers, Corps de Ballet Anton and Corps de Ballet Igor. They are white with red sable spots tipped with black. The boys were born April 12, 1954, sired by Tzar Boiyi of D'Listsa out of Nebacca Petrovna of Alpine. Anton died August 12, 1957 from a virus. Igor was seriously ill, but recovered to become Mrs Schwartz's devoted companion.

The thirty Tam-Boer Borzoi have moved to a new kennel; the construction done by Leonard Tamboer who is a contractor. They have a six-month-old litter of seven pups, all white with sable markings, and a 10-week-old litter.

The younger DeCraenes of Keyport NJ, Ray and Terry and daughter Bernadette, have a litter of 3 male pups. The dam is the sable and white Fandanga Von Bergland and the sire is their Djumber Von Bergland.

Russell and Cleoh Everhart of Michigan have 17 Borzoi. They have a litter sired by their Ch Jaguar Jehan of Malora, a red sable with white trim, out of their Firebird of Malora. One of the male pups was sold to an associate of Lois Kellog, who once was part owner of Valley Farm kennels and later started the American Perchino kennels. Lois, now deceased, had nearly 200 Borzoi and was very active in the breed 25-30 years ago.

Mrs Emma Denton's big brindle and white male, Prince Nicholas, sired a litter of 8 pups. The dam is Sniezhinka of Romanoff and the breeder is Kenneth Robinson of East Orange NJ.

May 23, 1957, Weldon and Kay McCluskey's female Nijinsky of Baronoff, had 2 huge pups via a Caesarian. They are registered as Alexis of Baronoff and Ajax of Baronoff. Sire is the McCluskeys Ch Rachmaninoff who is the model for the Wolfschmidt Vodka ads. Kay McCluskey has been showing Count Boris Patri, of Winjones and Adams bloodlines.

Fleurette of Woodcourt of Robwood owned by Joy Sari Brewster, Robwood kennels in upstate New Your had a litter this summer.

Ethel Bromley, Bromley kennels of Hudson Falls NY, has a litter out of her Sophia, a litter sister of Ch Boi of Rolling Meadows. The 8 pups, white with silver markings, were sired by Mrs Bromley's white Yelmorb Kolchak.

Howard Rackliffe's apricot and white Chara had 9 puppies sired by Oregar, a well known stud of Wieckert breeding, owned by Frank Marshall of Sinsbury Connecticut. Both sire and dam are of Bransgore, Glenwild and Mogedo bloodlines. Pups are white marked with grey, self gold and self reds.

The white male Warhill's Gonchaya, owned by breeders William Shepard & Harry Ferguson, won Winners Dog at his second show. This yearling is from the first Warhill litter, and is out of Kotlas of Mettler Hobby Farm. On July 25, 1957, Warhills second litter was born; 7 pups in colors ranging from silver and white, to almost solid black. Sire is Ch Jaguar Jehan of Malora. The dam is Kotlas of Mettler Hobby Farm, called Varga. Her bloodlines have Ch Adams Bolshoi, Ch Ivan of Fergovia and Ch Vigow of Romanoff. There are 6 adult Borzoi at Warhill kennels.

Jean and Russ Whisler of Manassas, VA have a boarding kennel. Their Haljean kennels had two litters early in 1957. In September, they had a litter of 8 pups, all black with almost identical white markings. Dam is the black with white, Haljean's Mystery (by Haljean's Beau Geste x Haljean's Starlight of Malora). Sire is the tri colored Dark Hazard of Malora (by Ch Splendour of Malora out of the French import Dione des Mariettes). There are 7 adult Borzoi at Haljean. In December 1957, Haljean's Moonlight of Malora whelped 9 pups, sired by Ch Amurat Von Merbody. Jean Whisler recently sold a white and gold female to the Horstings of Flushing NY. Lt Katherine Ames has been stationed overseas. She owned the red female Ch Haljean's Zorka (by Zyclon of Mogodo x Lady Coguette of Keys Farm).

In California, James and Betty Forry (Oakshade) had a litter of 5 males 3 females, June 10. They were sired by Ch Zonazo Perchinoff CD (Ch Rubles Perchino x Ch Lady Bolshoi) out of Marbob's Toniscott of Malora CD (Barinoff Ambasssador x Lucky Lady of Barnaigh). The Forrys' white male with sable

markings, Taras Bulba of Suntan, finished June 2, with 3 straight majors.

June 4, 1957, breeder Randy L'Ete of San Francisco, got a litter of 4 males and 5 females from Ch Corps de Ballet Foutte (Ch Ataman of Alpine x Nebeca Petrovna of Alpine). The sire is Ch Corps de Ballet Fokine (Tzar Boiyi of D'Lisitsa x Nebeca Petrova of Alpine). The pups are mostly white with red or cream markings and two are self whites.

August 8, 1957, breeder Carla Alioshin (Yermak Kennels) got one self red male with white trim out of dam Ch Uda Adams. Sire is the white with gold markings Ramadan Cygne. Breeder Miss Dorothy Harris got 4 males out of Ch Gradina of Grador.

Eileen Worthing, Malora kennels Phoenix AZ, had a litter May 21, 1957. The sire is Winjones Paskoss and the dam is Bright of Barnaigh. One male is a self black with white trim and tan, and the other is a self grey with white trim. The females are one self grey with white trim, one white with sable markings, one white with silver grey markings and two self sable with white trim. September 5, 1957, Malora kennels had a litter of six sired by French import Dikar Des Mariettes out of Tiger Lily of Malora. One male is a silver grey with white trim and the other a self gold with white trim. The females are a self gold with white trim, a self sable with white trim, a sable-brindle with white trim and one self blue with white trim. 4 males & 1 female, were born November 3, 1957. Their sire is Ch Splendour of Malora (Barinoff Ambassador x Lucky Lady of Barnaigh), and the dam is Kismet of Malora (Barinoff Ambassado x the French import Weschiks). All are self blacks with white trim and tan points. 3 males and 3 bitches were born November 14, 1957, mostly white with markings ranging from red to sable to black. Their sire is A Knight to Remember of Malora (Ramaden Cygne x Ch Zelda Shaun of Malora). Their dam is the French import Dione des Mariettes (Ch Asmondy de Norton Hall x Yrina of Norton Hall). From a litter born early in 1957, Eileen Worthing shipped Mirth of Malora and Vicereina of Malora to their new owner in New York. They were sired by Black Watch of Barnaigh (by Ch Winjones Lebid) out of Rozita of Malora (from Canadian Romanoff lines). §
