1939 – March 27, 2020

He received the Bronze Star and Air Medal during his years of service to our country. Though not interested in breeding, Joe loved owning and showing Borzoi. He acquired dogs from Rising Star, Topflight and Khanzade Kennels. Joe was heavily involved in BCOA in the 90s and served as President from 1993-1995. Mrs. Barbara Anne Brown Ciravolo – August 24, 2020

A loving mother and wife, Barbara passed away after a short illness. Born in Atlanta, Barbara was a daughter of the late Walter Brown and Claire Buff Brown of Sandy Springs, GA. She loved gardening, art, horses, fish, cats and dogs; especially Borzoi, which she bred under the kennel name Welkin. She graduated from Furman University with a BS in Biology and continued on to get her MS in botany from the University of Georgia, investigating the genetics of the Morning Glory plant. She worked at the Savannah River Ecology Lab, where she met and a few years later married her husband, Thomas G. Ciravolo and had two wonderful daughters. She spent a few years at the University of South Carolina, developing and managing a unique mouse colony for DOE. She also helped manage the Aquarium, a local fish / pet store.

In addition to her husband and mother, Barbara is survived by her two daughters, Amy Ciravolo, West Columbia, SC; Amber Ciravolo, Las Vegas, NV; and a sister, Nancy (David) Shavin of Leesburg, VA.

Ardietta Thompson

March 16, 1929 – November 2, 2021



Ardietta was born on March 16, 1929, in Jackson, MN. She graduated from high school and then worked as a commercial artist for Gambel-Skogmo Company for 5 years. In 1953, Ardieta made the decision to enlist in the United States Navy. After basic training, she attended Hospital Corps School.

On May 24, 1955, while stationed at Camp Pendleton, CA, Ardieta Mae Joslin married fellow serviceman Paul Allen Thompson. After their enlistment, the Thompsons moved and lived in Decatur, IL until their move to Fond du Lac, WI in 1969. Ardieta worked as a professional artist for many years. She created gorgeous portraits of wildlife and pets, as well as commissioned portraits for private individuals.

When their children, Dan and Dana, were young and Paul was working nights, his concern for the safety of his wife and children led him to purchase their first Borzoi for companionship and security for his family. This addition to the Thompson family was the beginning of Dana Dan Borzoi.

The Thompsons Dana Dan Borzoi have always been synonymous with soundness, substance, and outstanding temperament. As a young child, Dana started handling their dogs in AKC conformation competition along with her parents. Together, the three traveled throughout the United States and Canada, garnering awards and recognition of their beautiful Borzoi. More importantly, to the Thompson family, were the friendships they developed with folks throughout the country—many friendships which are maintained yet today.

Sadly, Dana's older brother, Danny, passed away on August 25, 2021, after a battle with cancer. Later that fall, Ardieta was called to heaven on November 2, 2021. There is no doubt that Ardieta and Paul are today beaming with pride and love as their daughter, Dana, carries forward the Dana Dan Borzoi legacy and love of the breed in honor of her parents.

Frederick "Doc" Lord, DVM August 19, 1942 – June 24, 2021



Doc was born and grew up on a farm in Bondurant, Iowa, and was a dedicated animal lover from a very early age. His dreams were realized when he received the degree of Doctor of Veterinary Medicine from Iowa State University in 1967. Doc was a veterinarian for both large and small animals in private practice until 2003, when his passion for helping animals in distress led him to become a Humane Society officer, veterinarian and expert witness in animal abuse cases. He started an affordable vaccination and spay/neuter clinic for companion pets in 2014. Doc was forced into retirement in April 2021 by a rare and aggressive lymphoma that would take his life two months later.

Doc was a Borzoi Club of America Life Member. He and Barbara and their children owned and bred Borzoi (since 1984) and Whippets (since 2012) under the Warwind Farm, Reg'd. name. Doc was a driving force in the importation of quality Borzoi into the Warwind breeding program, emphasizing sound movement, a devoted temperament and good health.

The quiet kindness, friendship and love that Doc gave his friends and family made him someone you knew you were blessed to have in your life. The love and support Doc had for his family over the years has been unwavering and deep. Barbara, his wife of 43 years, his children Meghann (her husband, Miles), Joseph (his wife, Sara) and Kendra and his grandchildren Grace, Hope, Alex, Caleb and Josh miss him terribly each and every day.

Rebecca Smith

March 1, 1948 – August 3, 2021



Becky had an interesting life. She was a retired corrections officer for the state of Connecticut. Becky was also a member of The Village Players, the American Legion Auxiliary, the Somers, CT Volunteer Fire Department, and a life member of the Borzoi Club of America. Jessie Hamersma

October 6, 1932 – August 16, 2021

Jessie would best be known for her association with Lena Tamboer, her life-long friend for seven decades. She and Lena shared a love of Borzoi, Dachshund, and travel. Jessie obtained her first Borzoi in the 1950s and co-bred and showed with Lena. Together they traveled worldwide showing the Tamboer family Borzoi.

Although Jessie never had any children of her own, she helped raise her nieces, great-nieces, and great-nephews. She loved going to the Jersey Shore with family. She loved to knit and gave her time by volunteering at her church and the Christian Health Care Center. Her true passion in life was her love of dogs. She was an active member of both the Borzoi Club of America and the Borzoi Club of Greater New York, acting as secretary of BCOA for many years. She was a founding member of BCGNY and was the club's first President. She treated her dogs as her children, especially her Dachshund, Sonny.



Redbird Adams

– October 15, 2021



Phrases like "larger than life" and "legend in her own time" come to mind when one thinks of Redbird Adams. Redbird's Royal Russian Borzoi, were larger than life as well, with the males of her line measuring up to 36 inches and well known for their hunting prowess. Redbird's Royal Russian Borzoi can be found behind many lines today if one goes back far enough. Rumor has it that she was born Betty Smith and was not actually Native American. Others say that the government took her from her original people and adopted her into a western European family so she could be brought up with that society's culture and education, which did happen back in the day. Whichever the case, there is no doubt that Redbird was a self-made presence to be reckoned with. We may never know for sure, but she would likely want the fancy to remember her riding into town in her red Cadillac convertible, hair flowing, with 3 Borzoi in the back seat! Lillian Beverly (Bev) Max

August 13, 1937 – October 23, 2021



Bev and her husband Ed lived in Texas, California and Maryland before moving to Arizona in 1980. They enjoyed golfing, bowling, playing bridge and shared a love of dogs. Although never a BCOA member, she had a long love affair with Borzoi. She had one from Ken and Virginia Graf (Bucksilver) named Willow. In 1998, Bev and Ed got two littermates from Toni Paskey (Tominot): Nicky and Edy. She also had several rescue dogs (not all Borzoi) and was a big help to Toni Paskey with rescue efforts. She created her own pet-sitting business, Bev's Happy Hounds, and got to know countless pets and their humans in the Tatum Ranch area of Cave Creek and beyond. She will be missed.

Dan Averill, Avatar Borzoi

January 5, 1958 - September 27, 2021

I remember very clearly the day Dan and I saw our first Borzoi. We were looking at kennels, trying to find a place we felt comfortable leaving our dog Bazzi, an Irish Setter/Lab mix, while we went on a trip. We walked into the kennel office and there was this beautiful Borzoi hanging out with the owner. At that moment Dan fell in love with the breed. It would be a few more years before he could bring a Borzoi into our family, but that day cemented his love of the breed. In 1993, we were finally ready as a family to get our first Borzoi. We went to dog shows, visited breeders, looked at multiple litters and finally settled on a girl from Louise Seigert, Cordova Mishkova Warwings.



On that Day in 1993, when we brought Wings home, Dan found a passion that would last close to thirty years. He loved going to dog shows almost as much as he loved his dogs. He loved the atmosphere ringside, seeing all the different breeds, the noise, the hustle and bustle. He especially loved outdoor shows. He would set up our site with the pop-up, grooming equipment, a little table for his coffee maker, then put the chairs out front and just enjoy watching the dogs in the different rings.

We often talk about our love for these dogs; I'd like to tell a story of the love these dogs have for us. Dan got sick and passed very quickly. He had been in the hospital for a week when it was decided he should move to hospice care but was too weak to go home. All Dan could talk about was wanting to go home so he could see his dogs. The hospice nurse assured him his dog could be with him in the hospice facility.

While I went with Dan in the transport from the hospital to hospice, our son went home and got Dan's girl Emma, his heart dog. I met them at the entrance to take them to Dan's room. Emma knew he was there and this 11-year-old, slightly arthritic old girl was dragging our son down the hall. She walked into Dan's room, threw herself on his bed and just let him hold her and bury his face in her fur. For the next week, while Dan was in hospice, Emma was with him. We brought her bed from home so she could watch over him. It didn't matter if the door was open or closed, Emma would only leave his room when we forced her to go home at night. At his funeral, we lifted her up so she could see him one last time. She kept going back, jumping up on the edge of his casket, sniffing him, touching his hand with her nose. Emma sleeps in the closet, under his clothing, every once in a while taking an item off a hanger to sleep on. The bond Dan and Emma shared has lasted past his death.

Rest in peace Dan, we know you were met at the Rainbow Bridge by Wings, Toski, Magic, Lady, Leggs, Lightning, Chanter, Blaze, Sonnet, Stella and of course Bazzi. Written with Love By Janet Averill.

Over the years, Barbara was a tireless worker for BCOA, especially when it was held in Rhode Island and she continued to work for and at the Nationals over the years.



Sara Whittington

November 19, 2021



Sara and her Chataqua Borzoi were a driving force in Texas for decades. During her lifetime Sara produced many champions, including two #1 (Breed System) Borzoi. One of her first and most noted dogs was the handsome BIS, BISS Ch. Chataqua's Vladimir Bolshoi. Sara had a unique ability to see and nurture great potential in puppies and juveniles who would later achieve success and go on to contribute nicely to the breed. She also loved bringing new people into the fold and was a superb mentor. She started many a young breeder who have gone on

to figure prominently in the breed, on their paths to success. Sara, your legacy lives on.

Joel Keller Chaney

October 24, 1944 – January 22, 2022

Joel and his wife, Camelle, lived in Ohio, where they raised a daughter, Erica, and a son, Joel. They bred a couple of litters of Borzoi using the kennel name Rohnoke. Their first homebred champion was finished in 1986: Ch Rohnoke's Arbor Vitae (Ch Seabury's Damon x Kelcrest Starshine). Joel was known for his quiet good humor and good sportsmanship and was an excellent handler. Joel handled Rohnoke's Sunkist Orange to RWB at the 1989 MBC specialty at Detroit over 68 other bitches and later finished Sunny (Ch Rohnoke's Arbor Vitae x Ch Seabury's Dina). Joel handled Regius Rohnoke Moonchild to first in open, and then to WB at the 2004 BCOA specialty over 167 bitches. Joel and Camelle were BCOA members for about 20 years and are life members of the Midwest Borzoi Club. Joel served MBC as treasurer in the 1980s. Joel and Camelle helped on committees and at numerous events. Joel served on the show committee for the BCOA specialty in Ohio in 2004. They then gradually phased out of Borzoi to show and breed Maine Coon cats. Joel will be missed by many.



Charles Daniel Greene

December 10, 1953 – March 14, 2022



Charles was an animal lover all his life, but really found his passion with Borzoi and lure coursing. He campaigned his beloved Serrano (MBIF DC Aria Svara Serrano Ex Libris MC FCh LCM LCX3 GRC CGC CAX) to AKC #1, ASFA #3 Lure Coursing Borzoi in 2009. Grudgingly, he would exhibit in conformation. As an Air Force veteran, he nearly saluted Jane Forsyth when she awarded him Winners Dog. He volunteered for both NJ Sheltie Rescue (SSPSNJ) and National Borzoi Rescue

Foundation and could be counted on to spend many hours driving dogs up and down the east coast. Outside of dogs, he was a voracious reader, an accomplished chess player and delighted in baroque chamber music.

Grace D. Conally

October 20, 1931 – March 1, 2022



Grace Strattan graduated from high school in 1949. With her graduation money she bought her first Borzoi, Varga. She had her when she married my dad and Varga was one of my first babysitters. Mom started going to dog shows where she met Dr Charles H. Conally. In 1959 they married and began to grow the ValaRama Kennels with Borzoi that became well known around the country and through the world.

Besides Varga, the next dog I remember was Prince, he was a big rust-colored male that followed me everywhere and Mom used to laugh about my bodyguard. I loved him and all the Borzoi brothers and sisters I had.

Dr. Conally and Mom grew their breed, introducing many colors into the standard, black, browns, bridles, gray, along with some whites. Their love for the breed was amazing and as members of the Borzoi Club of America and the Midwest Borzoi Club they became powerhouses in the 1960s and '70s.

Detroit became the hub for Borzoi in the late '60s and '70s. Detroit Kennel Club played host to the Midwest Borzoi Club Specialty and there were parties and events showcasing the breed. The meetings were filled with fun things; the auctions and banquets were not to be missed, as the items were always top notch and unique.

Mom and her creativeness were first-rate entries for the auction, some of them included decoupage purses, painted mirrors, stained glass etched windows, trophies. Her items were one of a kind and sought after.

Grace served as the Borzoi Club of America's President for several years, bringing change and excellence to the breeds, standards, and rules. I remember their specialty shows in Philadelphia were awesome and she was so pleased with their successes. Dr. Conally was so proud of his partner in life.

Dr. Conally and Grace were leaders in the breed. He became a well-respected hound breed judge and Mom judged some clinics and matches, always showing her love for the breed. She would go to shows throughout her years always searching out her beloved big Borzoi. She mentored many new exhibitors of the breed over the years and followed their achievements, always having a kind word of wisdom or advice. Trying to help always, that is Grace's legacy.

Dr. Conally died in 1972 and a couple years later Mom started working for Bow Dog Shows, now MB-F Dog Shows. She worked there for 28 years, never wavering from her love of Borzoi. She made the entries right for the breed so that it was timely and gave the exhibitors time to prepare for the ring. Every show she would go see her Borzoi and get licks, hugs, and paws; they knew she was a friend and showed her their love.

Mom had Borzoi into the '80s with her last from Redbird Adams, Heno. He was her puppy who grew enormous and was a huge lapdog. He joined the ranks of the great ValaRama Borzoi Prince, Alupka, Ramadi, Flame, Stormy, Cheetah, Johni, Lure, Pandora, and Phoenix. Their puppies became champions, far and wide.

Honestly, Mom talked about getting a puppy just last summer. Borzoi were in her blood. RIP Mom, Grace D. Conally. Say hi to Dr. CC; miss you both more than you will ever know. \$

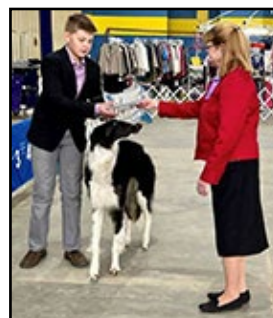

Setting The Record Straight on Borzoi Heart Comments

During the recent National, I overheard some comments that I felt needed addressing. It is not that this was the first clinic where I have heard comments like these, nor did they come from just one person. What bothered me about these comments is the frequency I have heard them over the years and it shows a misunderstanding of some important points about hearts/heart screenings and the overall complexities of medicine and ultrasound.

Comment 1: The cardiologist was just trying to find something/fail dogs.

First, no cardiologist is going to spend all day doing a clinic just to fail dogs. They seriously have better things to do with their time.

Second, it is, in fact, the job of the cardiologist doing the clinic to look for abnormalities and document them. This really is the whole purpose of health testing our dogs - find something early or as soon as one can so that the breeder can make a more informed decision about how or whether to breed an animal or how to continue with an animal's offspring in the next generation. We health test our dogs to help prevent us from unknowingly passing serious health problems on to the animal's progeny. Mostly, as Borzoi owners, we get the A-OK normal result. So getting an abnormal result can be a real shock. Getting bad news is never pleasant, especially when it happens to the culmination of your breeding program. But this is why we do this. So we know. So we can breed accordingly. Because we are not breeding ornaments, we are breeding living, breathing, feeling creatures who deserve to live long healthy lives.

Comment 2: This cardiologist does not know what he/she is doing because my dog has gotten tested every year and every time the result has been normal!

First, things change. This is the very reason why cardiac and eye certifications are only valid for one year and why the OFA recommends that thyroid screening be done at 2, 3, 4, 6, and 8 years of age. Not only can things change, but things can change within months. So no matter how many normal screenings a dog has had, those results will be normal ... until they are not. This is the nature of late onset diseases.

Second, this concept is extremely important for breeders to understand. One OFA clearance obtained at the age of 4 years means nothing when the dog is 6. Frankly, starting the day after that screening was obtained, its validity will begin to diminish throughout the year. It is extremely inaccurate to state that a dog is "heart healthy," or "clear of eye disease," or "thyroid normal" past the validity of the certificate. It is even more erroneous to think that a dog with a CHIC number that was obtained when the dog was young needs no further clearances before breeding, no matter

the age of the dog. It is inadvisable to breed a Borzoi to another who has not had recent health screenings. And with the information we have been gathering about the nature of Borzoi hearts, I cannot emphasize enough that the health status of your dog's heart can change in the blink of an eye.



Comment 3: These cardiologists don't know squat because they don't all agree on whether or not my dog has a problem or not. If they knew what they were talking about, everyone would agree and there would be no question as to what problem the dog has or does not have.

3a) Any doctor who knows what he or she is doing will know immediately what the problem is when they see it and will have no doubts.

First, there is nothing clear or easy about diagnosing health problems. If it were easy, then we would need neither doctors nor vets, nor would those professionals need to go to school for as long as they do to learn to practice medicine. Further, the practice of medicine is an incredibly complex, knowledge-intensive exercise often presented with ambiguous problems. This is one reason why it is known as "practice" whereas other professions do not use that term unless they are just learning their trade. There is a lot of judgment involved in medicine, so experience counts. It takes knowledge, yes, to be a good doctor or vet, but that alone will not help you make accurate diagnoses. Of course, some things are easier than others. Anyone can diagnose a compound fracture. The broken bone sticking out through a hole in the skin while the person or animal is screaming in pain is a dead giveaway. But the art of diagnosing is filled with nuance.

One of the ways medical professionals deal with this is the practice of making differential diagnoses (differentials). These differentials are reasonable alternatives to the preferred diagnosis a practitioner makes. Differential diagnoses are a very important part of medicine because they help a doctor or vet keep their mind flexible and open to other options other than their first assumption. No matter how much experience or how good a doctor/vet is at making accurate diagnoses, they will always have a list of differentials. We see these even on necropsy reports. In the case of sudden death, a good pathologist will state that no definitive cause of death was found, then list all the possible causes for what might have occurred, based on the nature of the death. These differentials are not the cause of death. The pathologist may favor one or more of the

differentials, especially when faced with a death as perplexing as sudden death; but without evidence, this is still not a diagnosis or evidence of exactly what caused the death.

When a vet/doctor examines a patient, they are developing a list of differentials in their mind. Then they will start doing tests of various sorts to gather evidence to help them sort through the differentials to find the most probable cause for the patient's complaint. Even vets/doctors, who are pretty sure their assumption about the cause of illness is correct, will still keep their mind open to other possibilities and do tests to confirm or refute their assumption. It is a lot like detective work and it is not easy to do.

So when you have a vet who does not look at your dog and announce the diagnosis immediately, especially if your dog is experiencing something out of the ordinary, this is not evidence that they are incompetent; it means that they are making no assumptions until they gather more evidence, and that is the kind of medical professional you want on your side when the diagnoses get difficult.

3b) When you have an uncommon problem, if your problem manifests in a different way than usual, or occurs in conjunction with another disease process that muddies the waters, you may find five different doctors who will give you a different cause for your problem should you seek alternate opinions. It is important to remember that just because one of these doctors gives you the answer you want to hear, or sounds authoritative or certain, it does not necessarily make that individual right.

Comment 4: I have seen enough echos on my dogs to know normal from abnormal and there was nothing abnormal about my dog's heart.

4a) I will go get another screening from a cardiologist who I know will pass my dog because he is a better cardiologist.

This type of comment is particular to cardiac examinations because unlike eye or thyroid exams, the owner can and often does watch while the exam is being done.

First, I do ultrasounds for a living on human beings and I can tell you with certainty that you absolutely do not know enough of what you are seeing to know whether or not the cardiologist made the right diagnosis on your dog. I am trained in abdominal, vascular, small parts, and OB/GYN ultrasounds and even though I use the same techniques as are used in Doppler echocardiograms, use Doppler techniques daily, and have taken a course dedicated to Doppler Physics, I can tell you definitely that I would never think that I knew enough from watching a cardiac examination of my dogs to know that the diagnosis was incorrect. I did at one point purchase a rather expensive textbook on echocardiography, thinking that I could use it to help myself understand the modality better in order to provide better guidance to the Borzoi community. Despite my training and experience, when I flipped through that extremely thick textbook, it became apparent that I was rather

foolish to think I could just quickly read it and understand things better. If I felt that way with my experience and training, how could someone without such training really have any kind of depth of understanding of what they are seeing with a Doppler echocardiogram?



4b) One of the things I did learn when scanning through that textbook was how nuanced echocardiography is. This should not have been surprising since I know from my own experience doing ultrasounds on other parts of the body that very little is clear cut but the nuance may well be greater with the heart, simply because it is a dynamic organ, constantly in motion. Depending on when the echocardiogram is done, one can see fluctuations in the measurements, even with the same practitioner with the same ultrasound machine in the same office with the same dog. Because of their heart conditions, both my dogs must have Doppler echocardiograms at frequent intervals. When I compare their measurements from one exam to the other, sometimes the numbers are better, sometimes worse. The overall trend of my DCM dog's measurements are still heading in the negative direction, as is expected for a chronic, degenerative disease. If I did not know this and focused on one of the exams where his numbers were "better," I might be able to convince myself that my dog really did not have DCM and his heart was recovering. Deciding such a thing and removing him from the care he so desperately needs would hasten his death quite rapidly, when he might otherwise live very close to a normal life with proper veterinary care.

Knowing that, if your Borzoi is in the very early stages of DCM, it is very easy to have one cardiologist diagnose DCM based on an echo and another cardiologist pass the dog as normal. The heart is dynamic; it is changing constantly and disease states do not follow straight, predictable, sequential paths.

Further, when we talk about "normal" measurements, we are talking about ranges of numbers. So when we talk about the size of a normal kidney, depending on which reference you use, the range of measurement is about 9 – 14 centimeters in adult human beings. The size of the kidney can vary based on the patient's body, primarily height, but also body mass index. Of course it could not be that simple. As a person ages, their kidney size will decrease. Also, if a kidney is chronically failing the size also decreases. The rule of thumb is that a kidney that is less than 8 centimeters long should be suspected of being in chronic renal failure. But is that true no matter what part of the 9-14 cm normal range your kidneys fall into? A 9 cm kidney only has 1 cm to shrink before it gets to the borderline measurement for chronic renal failure. What does that mean for a person who started out with 14 centimeter kidneys? What measure would mean chronic renal failure? Does a 14 centimeter kidney have to shrink to almost half of its former size before a concern for chronic kidney disease is considered? No. That formerly 14 centimeter kidney with chronic renal disease would probably fall in the normal range of measurement.

Within bodies, there is a range for normal and that range often overlaps with what can be considered abnormal. So thinking of hearts, this is why, even though a cardiologist gets something as concrete as a measurement, there could still be some question as to whether or not the heart is normal. The ranges for normal and abnormal overlap and there are a lot of parts that must be considered. The cardiologist then has to use other criteria seen during the echo, the dog's weight, and other factors to try to make a decision. Different cardiologists will make different decisions based on what they see, their expertise, and their experience. That experience is not necessarily dependent on the number of years doing echocardiograms, but instead, how many times the cardiologist has been confronted by similar questions, made a decision, and been able to follow the patient to see if the right determination was made.

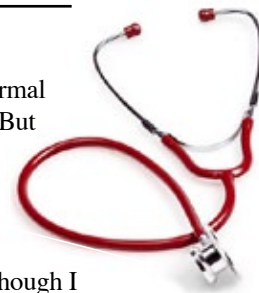
So bottom line, there are aspects of echocardiography where experienced, expert, highly knowledgeable cardiologists will differ in their diagnosis. The key to knowing who is right is making sure repeated follow-ups are made to evaluate the status of the heart over time. It is also important to remember that the clinician with the most authoritative pronouncement of a diagnosis is not necessarily going to be the one who gives you the correct assessment of your hound's health.

Comment 5: My dog's echo/Holter was not good because when the echo/Holter was done my dog was scared/just finished running around/didn't like the doctor/doesn't like being manhandled.

First, hearts are supposed to function normally even during times of stress, excitement, peak moments of exercise, and during the cool-down stage after exercise. In fact, in human medicine, stress tests are used to diagnose heart disease that might otherwise remain hidden if the heart is not stressed during the examination. If your dog is stressed, excited, scared or tired from exercise and an abnormality is seen, then take serious note because you may have been lucky to have found something early. This is, in fact, exactly how I discovered the heart disease in one of my personal dogs. This dog did not like to lose control, so the act of picking him up and putting him on a table was very stressful for him. I had been taking Booker for echos at a nearby show for several years after his sibling was diagnosed with DCM. One year, we put him on the table, the cardiologist put her transducer on Booker's chest and we witnessed three significant runs that occurred in rapid succession, one following the other. The cardiologist estimated they occurred at a rate of between 250 - 300 beats per minute. Runs at this rate are extremely malignant and put a dog at high risk for sudden death. Because she had not started taking readings and we were only seeing the images of the heart during these events we did not have documentation and the exact speed of these arrhythmias. However, because we actually were able to see them, Booker's heart had let us know it had a serious problem. I am very lucky Booker did not die.

After collecting ourselves, the cardiologist began the exam and Booker's heart was perfectly normal with no further arrhythmias

seen. At least the structure of heart was normal and its ability to pump blood was normal. But his heart was truly not normal due to the presence of those arrhythmias we glimpsed.



I say this discovery was very lucky, even though I literally spent the rest of the afternoon crying. It was lucky because it may well have saved Booker's life. Because we saw those arrhythmias that probably only happened because Booker was stressed, the cardiologist prescribed antiarrhythmic medication and I stopped taking Booker to screenings and put him in the care of that cardiologist. Because of the early intervention and frequent monitoring for changes, we were able to put Booker on the appropriate medications when he eventually did develop DCM. Because of this excellent care and appropriate application of medications, Booker died at the age of 11 years, not because of his heart condition, but because of hemangiosarcoma. Seeing that very frightening arrhythmia saved Booker's life. Had he not been stressed enough to produce those runs, his care would have been delayed for a year and a half, assuming I was continuing with the echos, longer had I stopped doing annual echos. Booker's sister and brother, who did not have an early intervention, both lived less than a year after diagnosis of their DCM.

So, believe me when I tell you that doing a Holter or an echo when your dog is stressed, afraid, excited, or has a heart pumping hard because of exercise, is good. And if you happen to catch an abnormality, pay attention and act accordingly. Action on your part may just save your dog and your breeding program.

Comment 6: My dog's Holter was bad but when we did the echo it was perfect, so our dog is heart healthy!

6a) I heard some dogs with normal Holters dropped dead, so this proves they did not die of a heart problem/ this proves that Holter testing does not work.

First, the Holter and the echo are testing for two different things. Just because one is normal and the other is not does not mean the abnormal result was incorrect. A Borzoi can have arrhythmias, even life threatening arrhythmias, and still have a normal echo. In fact, such a finding is the hallmark of a heart rhythm disturbance caused by something wrong with the electrical system of the heart (channelopathy). It can also happen during the very early stages of DCM, before any structural changes to the heart can be seen on an echo, because the changes that are starting are occurring at the cellular level. It takes a while for those cellular changes to cause structural changes to the heart. (Think of a building built with defective bricks. The building may stand tall for many years before it collapses). So if your dog has a bad Holter, pay attention. Take your dog to a cardiologist. Make a plan to obtain regular echoes and Holters to monitor your dog. Remember, the earlier you catch cardiac changes and get your dog onto medication, the better the chance your dog will live a longer life of good quality and

the better chance you have of making informed breeding decisions to protect your bloodlines and the breed.

6b) Yes, some dogs who had good Holters have dropped dead. This is neither an indication that Holter testing is worthless, nor does it prove that what caused the sudden death was due to something else other than the heart. Arrhythmias can be very difficult to catch. Sometimes, they will only happen in certain situations. In human medicine, diagnosing some forms of arrhythmias can be very difficult to achieve even using the tools that are available to human medicine. So, the lack of ability to see an arrhythmia on one day out of 365 does not mean that every day there are no arrhythmias, or the next time your dog went running around the yard without the Holter on, there were no PVCs. After all, if I were to follow you around one day and never observed you brushing your dogs, I would be completely wrong to assume that you never brushed your dogs, ever. Do not make that mistake with Holter findings. Further, if we are dealing with a disease like DCM that develops over time and typically hits as the dog gets older, then every Holter can very well be normal until the point where the heart begins to succumb to the changes that will eventually develop into DCM. Then the Holters will stop being normal.

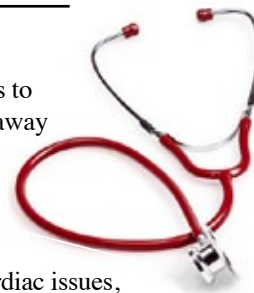
Comment 7: Those Texas dogs have a problem with sudden death. It must be something in the environment that is causing this.

Simply, no. Borzoi are dying of sudden death all over the United States. They are dying of sudden death in Canada. They are dying of sudden death in Russia. Borzoi are dying of sudden death all over Europe. Borzoi probably also die of sudden death in South America, Central America, and Africa; we just have not heard of any, yet. So, no. The problem is not just with Texas dogs or dogs in the Southwest, or dogs in the South. Nor is sudden death due to licking Texas toads, stray electricity, or the water (remember, people drink the water too and they are not dropping dead mostly in Texas). There are many other variations of this I have heard. Simply, no.

That said, there is one environmental cause for DCM and sudden death that is definitely found in Texas and has the potential to be found in the southern half of the US: Chagas Disease. To date, and to my knowledge, no Borzoi that has been diagnosed with DCM has tested positive for this disease. Regardless, any Borzoi that lives in the southern half of the US and is found to have arrhythmias or is diagnosed with DCM should be tested for Chagas disease. Also, any dogs who spent time in the southern half of the US and then moved further north that later develop arrhythmias or DCM should be tested for Chagas disease. The best lab to use for this is at Texas A&M.

The cold, hard fact of this problem is that Borzoi die of sudden death more frequently than other breeds. When a disease is found more frequently or only in one or several breeds and not in others, that is a red flag that the cause is genetic. We need to accept that sudden death has a genetic cause and Borzoi from all over the

world are affected. You cannot import dogs to get away from it. You cannot move to get away from it. The solution is in the hands of Borzoi breeders. Until we recognize this fact, we cannot take steps to reduce the incidence of the problem. It is imperative that Borzoi breeders get up to speed on cardiac issues, cardiac health screenings, breeding to decrease genetic disease, and breeding to maintain genetic diversity. We will be needing all those tools if we hope to maintain the good health of this breed.



Pending Canine Health Foundation approval, the Borzoi community is about to delve into its first breed specific study, focused on what is postulated to be Borzoi DCM. It is imperative for breeders to be conversant with the topics mentioned in the paragraph above or we could risk severe damage to the genetic and physical health of our beloved breed. The Borzoi Club of America Health Committee urges Borzoi breeders and owners to come to us with questions or concerns. I. General (registrations, point scales, event entries)

Per an AKC report, 516,800 dogs were registered in 1962, an increase of 4.8% over 1961. 275 Borzoi were registered in 1962, compared to 219 registered in 1961. Borzoi were ranked in 62 place out of 115 breeds. Poodles were the most popular with 123,865 registered, followed by Beagles, Chihuahuas, German Shepherd Dogs, Dachshunds, Pekingese, Collies, Cocker Spaniels, Pomeranians and Boston Terriers.

There were 479 all breed shows held during 1962. The largest all-breed show in 1962 was The International Kennel Club of Chicago with 2277 dogs shown, followed by Santa Barbara CA, Westminster NY, Harbor Cities at Long Beach CA, Santa Ana Valley at Anaheim CA, Trenton NJ, Westchester at Purchase NY, Kennel Club of Philadelphia, Orange Empire CA and Del Monte CA.

The largest breed entries, ten thousand entries or more, were German Shepherd Dogs, followed by Poodles, Dachshunds, American Cocker Spaniels, Boxers and Collies. There were 994 entries of Borzoi, plus 48 entries of Borzoi Champions, and 23 Borzoi finished championships.

In 1962, the country was divided into 5 divisions for points. The scale of points for Borzoi was the minimum 2/2 3/3 4/4/ 5/5 6/6 for West and South, Pacific Northwest and Hawaii. For Borzoi in the North and East division shows, it took 2 dogs/2 bitches for 1 point, 3 dogs/3 bitches for 2 points, 4 dogs/4 bitches for 3 points, 6 dogs/5 bitches for 4 points and 8 dogs/6 bitches for 5 points. (This division contained the states of WI, IL, IN, OH, MI, PA, NY, NJ, MD, VA, DE, CT, RI, MA, ME, NH, VT). For Borzoi in the California division shows, it took 2 dogs/2 bitches for 1 point, 3 dogs/4 bitches for 2 points, 5 dogs/7 bitches for 3 points, 6

dogs/8 bitches for 4 points and 7 dogs/9 bitches for 5 points.

Per a BCOA report, Borzoi won nineteen Group 1, fifteen Group 2, seventeen Group 3, fifteen Group 4, and two Best In Show (won by Ch Bronze Falcon of Woodhill). 252 individual Borzoi were shown in 275 shows. The largest Borzoi entry, 42, was at the June 23 Harbor Cities show in California.

The BCOA Minutes have been summarized.

February 12, 1962 Annual Membership meeting held after the Westminster show at Hotel Piccadilly, New York City. Present were Mrs Grace Dusenbury, Mrs Philip (Kathryn) Begley, Miss Harriet Crane, Mrs Ellison (Irmgard) Thompson, Miss Lydia Suchoff, Mrs Gladys Dykstra, Miss Jessie Hamersma, Miss Lena Tamboer, Mr & Mrs John (Mary) Gamber, Clarence DeCraene Sr, Leonard Tamboer, Mrs Katherine McCluskey, Mrs Lorraine Groshans. Mrs Phydema Gillette, Louis Murr, Mrs Nellie Hilsmier, and Eli Fleischer.

Leonard Tamboer and Harriet Crane audited the books and found them balanced. The annual specials for 1962 was approved by the AKC*. 35 ballots were returned and counted at this meeting. Elected for 1962 are President John H Gamber, First Vice President Leonard Tamboer, Second Vice President: Mrs Elizabeth Forry, Third Vice President: Mrs Nellie Hilsmier, Fourth Vice President: Mrs Dixie Bilodeau, Secretary: Mrs Lorraine Groshans, Treasurer: Mrs Kathryn Begley, Delegate to the AKC: Weldon McCluskey, Board of Governors:

The Borzoi Club of Northern California was given permission to change their specialty from Sacramento to San Mateo on November 18, 1962. The Borzoi Club of California was given permission to hold their specialty at the Harbor Cities show June 23, 1962.

A field trial report was given by Phydema Gillette, that for the past 3 years coursing trials have been held and rules are being formalized. She is in contact with the AKC and working to get the AKC to recognize this activity. (*Editor's note: these trials were open field trials, hunting hares in California*). Lena Tamboer reported that the lunch at the 1962 Specialty will cost \$1.50 payable in advance. Grace Dusenbury reported that the brochure was at the printers, and will include the chart with the dog. New members approved were Mrs John Darr Fremont OH, Mrs Bruna Henry Dayton OH, Mrs Charles (Patti) Robinson Laurelton NY and Mrs Therese Schein Cleveland Heights Ohio. Gwen Pinette was approved as a life member. The annual awards for 1961 were presented to the owners. After the meeting, Grace Dusenbury showed slides of Borzoi at the specialties going back to 1955.

*Starting in December 1952, the AKC rule was: "Annual specials are prizes offered by member or non-member specialty clubs for outright award at the end of a twelve month period, the award to be based on the most number of wins at shows, in a designated competition, throughout the period. Only those clubs which have held specialty shows can offer annual specials. Specialty clubs must submit the list of their proposed prizes to the AKC for approval." "The Borzoi Club of America offers to Members only, to be competed for during the year 1962, the following Annual Specials - Sterling Silver Trophy For Best of Breed, Sterling Silver Trophy For Best of Opposite Sex, Sterling Silver Trophy for Best American Bred. Best of Breed Trophy will be awarded

to the owner of the Borzoi, dog or bitch, accumulating the greatest number of points (AKC rating) by virtue of being placed Best of Breed or higher. If the dog or bitch awarded Best of Breed is already a champion of record, that dog or bitch will be credited with the number of points it would have been awarded had it been entered in a regular class. Best of Opposite Sex Trophy will be awarded to the owner of the Borzoi, dog or bitch, of opposite sex to the Best of Breed winner, accumulating the greatest number of points (AKC rating) by virtue of Opposite Sex awards only. If the dog or bitch is already a champion of record, it will be credited with the number of points it would have been awarded had it been entered in a regular class. Best America Bred Trophy will be awarded to the owner of the Borzoi, dog or bitch, placing first in the American Bred Class the greatest number of times. In case of a tie, championship points acquired by virtue of these awards during the year, will determine the winner. The Presidential Award Sunburst Cup mounted with an Obedience Oscar will be awarded to the owner of the Borzoi, dog or bitch, accumulating the highest average in obedience trials (AKC rating) provided the dog or bitch has competed in five or more AKC point shows. The above Specials, offered at all shows held under AKC regulations, are void if won by dogs or bitches owned by non-members."

March 24, 1962 Board of Governors meeting held at the Holiday Inn Allentown PA. Present were John Gamber, Weldon McCluskey, Leonard Tamboer, Robert Bergeron, Lorraine Groshans, Kathryn Begley and Ann Stoudt. President John Gamber appointed the following committees: Auditing Robert Bergeron, Burton Axe, Leonard Tambour, Harriet Crane. Constitution and By Laws: El Fleisher, Dixie Bilodeau, Ann Stoudt. Aristocrat Gwen Pinette. Field Trials and Racing: Phydema Gillette, Joanne Weaver, Grace Dusenbury, Eli Fleisher. Exploration and Research: Genevieve Pitcock. Publications: Grace Dusenbury. Obedience: Gladys Dykstra, Gwen Pinette, Joanne Weaver. Bench Trophies and Awards: Lena Tamboer. 1963 Specialty show chairman: Irmgard Thompson and

Specialty Luncheon: Kathryn Begley. John Gamber presented a complete obedience report for 1961 noting that the 1961 winner of the Presidential Obedience award is Gladys Dykstra with Lady Tasha of Kamaroff CDX with an average score of 194. Mrs Begley reported that she has a supply of Borzoi notepaper available and will be ordering a new supply of Borzoi gummed seals. Both of these items may be ordered from her at \$1 a box. In regards to the club emblem, Mr Gamber stated that he was asking Louis Murr to submit photographs of Borzoi in motion. Until such time as the emblem is in a final state, the stationery will be printed as before. Much comment has been received concerning the single slate as provided for under our present by-laws. It was noted in the discussion that all nominating committees in the past have done commendable work in filling one slate. It was also noted that our by-laws provide for additional candidates on the ballot by petition. It was moved and approved, that a short history of the individual candidates be prepared by future nominating committees and sent out with the ballots. New members approved were Miss Shela Stoudt Emmaus PA, and Mrs Suzanne Pressman Norwood MA. Mrs Pressman owns two bitches Katish of Malora and Antiope of Tyree, plus pups. Shela Stoudt is the daughter of Ann Stoudt, and has one black and white male Borzoi Loral's Ardagan of Frontier, that she handles in the breed ring and is training for obedience. There was a discussion about selecting judges. It was approved to ask the exhibitors at the 1962 specialty to express their choices at the May meeting. The results would be the basis for the board's list of judges to be given to the 1963 show chairman to contact the judges in order. It was requested that new members provide a short introduction of themselves for publication in the Aristocrat. It was approved that members whose dues are unpaid by the specialty show will be dropped. It was approved that Grace Dusenbury be recommended for the 1961 Dog World award.

May 26, 1962 Board of Governors meeting and Membership meeting held at the Monmouth NJ show site, after the specialty. Present were Mrs Grace

Dusenbury, Mrs Philip (Kathryn) Begley, Miss Harriet Crane, Mrs Ellison (Irmgard) Thompson, Miss Lydia Suchoff, Polly Clement, Miss Lena Tamboer, Mr & Mrs John (Mary) Gamber, Clarence DeCraene Sr, Mrs Elizabeth Tamboer, Weldon & Katherine McCluskey, Mr & Mrs Albert (Lorraine) Groshans. Mrs Suzanne Pressman, Robert Bergeron, Melissa Cokefair and Eli Fleischer. Mrs Begley gave a treasury report that showed a balance of \$2129. After a discussion about judges, it was agreed that this club will select the judge and not the host club. The BCOA secretary will get approval of that judge from the host show superintendent. It was agreed to hold the specialty at Monmouth for one more year while investigating other locations such as the Trenton show. Mr Gamber presented the Dog World Award for Outstanding Service to Mrs Dusenbury. Mr DeCraene invited the club to hold a fun match and picnic at his home. It was agreed that this will be held in the fall, and members will be notified of the details later. New members approved were Martha Denton Nashville TN and Marcelle & Jacques Asselin Montreal Canada.

September 23, 1962 Board of Governors meeting held at the home of Clarence Decraene, Scobeyville NY following the picnic and match show. Present were John Gamber, Weldon McCluskey, Robert Bergeron, Grace Dusenbury, Irmgard Thompson, Lorraine Groshans. The request by the **Mid-West Borzoi Club**, Erma Denton Secretary-Treasurer, to hold their specialty in conjunction with the Berrien kennel club show June 23, 1963 in St Joseph MI, was approved. It was approved to offer a sterling silver trophy, value \$10, for Best of Breed at the 1963 Westminster show. A letter was read from the purchaser of a Borzoi puppy from a BCOA member asking the board to arbitrate the difficulties that had arisen from the sale. The board felt that BCOA has no jurisdiction over the business matters of any club member. Lorraine Groshans gave the financial report on the 1962 specialty: trophy donations and the rebate



from the 32 entries for an income of \$96, with expenses of \$61.47 (trophies, rosettes and mailings), for a profit of \$34.53. Irmgard Thompson, the 1963 show chairperson reported that she had contacted the Monmouth club's show chairperson and that judge Fairfield Pope Day's name has been submitted to the AKC for approval. Suggestions to decorate the benches at the next specialty show were given to the show chairman. Mrs Dusenbury reported that the Borzoi brochure have been widely distributed, even as far as England. The board reviewed the recommendation of the committee on annual awards, to change the American bred award to a point system. The board determined that the original purpose of the award was to further the showing of Borzoi in the America Bred classes would be better accomplished by keeping the rules for the award the same. No trace of the Borzoi die previously made up for the club can be found. A possible source of a Borzoi head emblem has been found in Canada and a sample will be requested for showing at the annual meeting in February. New members approved, Mrs Byron (Louenna) Avery Westminster MD and Mrs Louise Heaton Fairfax VA. Gloria Thompson was nominated for the Junior Handling award. Nominations of other eligible juniors may still be made. Mr Gamber reported on the Borzoi book which was started by a committee several years ago. Erma Denton has agreed to update the manuscript and make the necessary additions. Possible publishers will be investigated for a publication date next year for the BCOA's 60th anniversary.

December 9, 1962 Board of Governors meeting held at the Holiday Inn Allentown PA. Present were John Gamber, Weldon McCluskey, Leonard Tamboer, Lorraine Groshans, Grace Dusenbury with guests Mary Gamber, Harriet Crane and Lena Tamboer. The secretary reported that the AKC has approved Weldon McCluskey as BCOA's Delegate to the AKC. The AKC has approved the annual specials for 1963 which will be the same as 1962. New member approved Mrs Frances Schulz Massapequa Park Long Island NY. The board approved the request of the Borzoi Club of California

to hold its specialty show June 22, 1963 with the Harbor Cities show. The progress of the Borzoi book was discussed and several articles submitted by members will be considered. Lena Tamboer submitted her report on the Borzoi medal. The sample shown to the board was in copper, approximately one inch square with a Borzoi head impressed upon it. The medal will cost \$1 each in quantities of 100, plus shipping from Montreal. It was approved to order 100 medals which will be used on trophies and will be available for purchase by members. It was approved to hold a luncheon at the 1963 specialty.

Summary for 1962 (reported at the February 11, 1963 meeting). There 96 members including 4 life members, at the start of 1962. During the year 12 members were dropped for non payment of dues. 13 members joined during the year. There were four issues of The Aristocrat published, edited by Mrs Gwen Pinette, who also provided the Borzoi columns in 12 issues of the AKC Gazette. Mrs Elizabeth Tamboer provided a Borzoi column in the magazine Popular Dogs. The treasury had \$2072 at the end of 1962.
