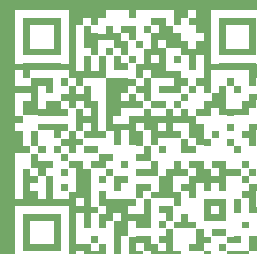

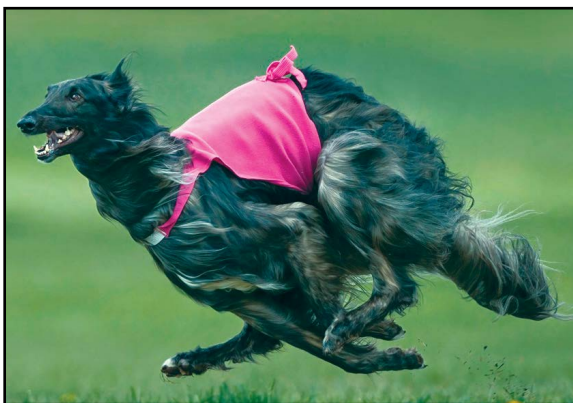

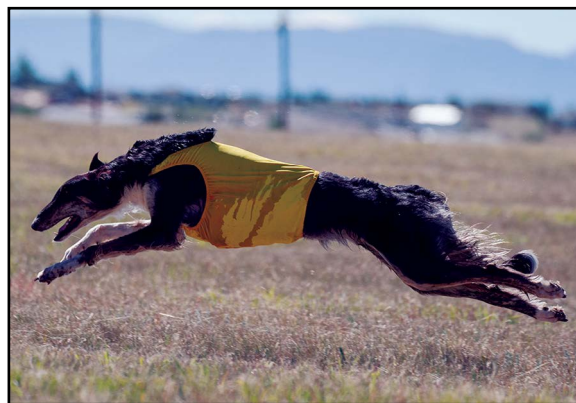

LENA TAMBOER — TAMBOER

January 15, 1933 - June 6, 2024

Lena was synonymous with Borzoi when Fred Vogel first met her in about 1978. Owning a Borzoi was a “dream-come-true” for Lena’s father, Len, Lena told us. He saw his first Borzoi as a child in his native Dirksland, Holland. The Tamboers purchased their first Borzoi in 1953 from Louis Murr, Romanoff Kennels, who is credited with being “Mr. Borzoi” in America at the time. The Tamboer Kennel was established in about 1956 in Mahwah, New Jersey. Together with her parents, Len and Elizabeth, and her best friend from school Jessie Hammersma, the Tamboer Borzoi were a force in the world of dog shows for almost three decades. The Tamboers also raised champion longhaired dachshunds. Later in her life, Lena turned her interest to the dachshunds.



Lena and her family were founders of The Borzoi Club of Greater New York. She was a lifetime member of the Borzoi Club of America and judged the national more than once. A hound judge, Lena traveled to many parts of the world judging.

Lena was loyal, generous and gracious and most of the time outspoken about Borzoi. She was loyal to the breed and to what Louis Murr had taught her and her parents about the correct type of Borzoi. For many years Lena wrote a column in *The Borzoi Quarterly* entitled “The Opinionated Lena.”

For most of her adult life, Lena was a lab technician working for Pfizer Pharmaceuticals in their cancer research center when she was not on the road showing the dogs. She had a greenhouse filled with orchids and camellias and was an avid collector of Borzoi antiques and all things Borzoi.

BARBARA ANN MICHALICK

August 17, 1945—December 13, 2024

Barbara was born in Jamaica, Long Island, NY, raised in Levittown and later in Wantagh, Long Island, NY. She was a resident of Virginia for 59 years and retired from the Defense Logistics Agency of the U.S. Government Department of Defense.



Barbara Ann was introduced to the Borzoi breed by her former husband who was Russian, and immediately fell in love with this wonderful breed. When she was ready to have a large breed dog, she acquired her first female companion Borzoi from Mary Vile and added the second retired Champion female from Mary at a later date.

Barbara dedicated her life up to her passing to help any Borzoi in need – near and far. Over the years she gave a permanent home to several Borzoi from owners who could not care for them any longer, and fostered/adopted multiple Borzoi through NBRF.

Her last two Borzoi were Violet and Anya, whom she loved dearly. Both of them are now in foster care with NBRF.

Barbara was the most selfless person I have ever known. She gave her all to help others in need. Barbara, you are dearly missed by many!

Pat, a loving wife, mother and grandmother, passed away at the age of 88 years and is survived by her husband, Jack, 3 children, 9 grandchildren and 9 great grandchildren.

As a young girl, Pat had seen a picture of a Borzoi and decided that was the dog for her, but it wasn't until around 1970 that she got her first one, a bitch named Afebra of Pillow Hill, bred by Lorraine Groshans of Loral Kennels. A year later she wanted another one, so Loral's Royal Charisma became Pat's first champion. Pat's first litter was Charisma bred to Hollingdahl Ivan of Silde. She chose Oaklara as a kennel name, the idea coming from the over 65 mature oak trees on their acreage, and she named her litters alphabetically.



Many litters followed and Pat also purchased or bred to some lovely dogs and racked up a long list of champions over the years. Some of her best that come to mind are Oaklara's Helter Skelter, Oaklara's Espresso and Oaklara's Ice Cream Sundae.

Pat became the perfect mentor for Susan Motisi's granddaughter Lily Butcher, who is thankful that Pat took the time to teach her so much and thinks about her when she goes into the show ring to this day. In the motel room Lily would do a little "fashion" show of clothes she brought and Pat would suggest what to wear to make her look more like a "professional handler". When Pat wasn't at a show, she always wanted to know how Lily did and to see pictures.

Pat also became a sought-after judge and judged the 1997 BCOA National in Atlanta, Georgia, one of the higher National entry totals. She cut back on her breeding and number of dogs she kept and traveled the world to judge. Pat was a lovely person and was always easy to talk to, very helpful, would answer your questions and give support. She will be very missed by the Borzoi world.

AMY BALTHROP — AKANNI

Passed away in October 2024

Amy passed away after a short battle with a rare form of Leukemia. She faced her illness with her signature fighting spirit.

Amy was both an artist and professional photographer who loved attending concerts and the theatre. She loved her dogs, musicals, jewelry, Disney and all things fun and silly. Her love of dogs, art, and photography collided into a collection of beautiful pieces memorializing the breeds she loved.



Amy grew up with dogs and horses. She became involved in the world of purebred dogs first through rescue in 1995 with both a Rhodesian Ridgeback and Borzoi. She competed with both in performance events, her dogs earning agility titles and their ASFA FChs and multiple best in fields. Her first Borzoi had more than 100 points and placements towards both her NACC and her NACM titles.

Amy became an AKC Breeder of Merit in both breeds, working actively to preserve unique lines. Her love of coursing led her to become an AKC and ASFA lure coursing judge in 2000. She remained active in both Rhodesian Ridgeback Rescue serving as the Rocky Mountain Rescue Coordinator for many years and assisted with Borzoi rescue over the years.

During the last two years of her life, Amy actively pursued her AKC Conformation judging license and formally registered her Kennel name, "Akanni." Her choice of kennel name is fundamental to how she lived her life. It means, "When you and I meet, you'll leave with a precious gift." Her most important legacy is an amazing network of friends across the world who have been brought together through the gift of sharing her amazing life.

CYNTHIA (CYNDI) DELL — MORGANDELL

Passed away in November 2024

Cyndi, a beloved member of the sighthound community and the heart behind Morgandell Borzoi and Silkens, passed away after a valiant fight with cancer. Just a few months earlier she also suffered the heartbreaking loss of her husband and partner, Bill Hemby.

Cyndi made her home in Grass Valley, CA where she and Bill shared a life surrounded by the beauty of nature and the joy of their dogs. Before relocating from Washington State, Cyndi had already earned a well-deserved reputation for her Borzoi. Her thoughtful and collaborative breeding program included partnerships with kennels such as Chulista, Dar Morev, and Virshina, reflecting her commitment to preserving and improving the breed.



Cyndi was a mentor and friend to many in the Borzoi community. She generously shared her knowledge and passion, guiding newcomers with patience and care. Whether she was teaching about structure and movement or helping someone navigate their first dog show, her mentorship left a lasting legacy. She was known for the extra love and attention she gave to socializing her

puppies — sending them off for “spa weekends” at friends’ homes or training them with a sense of fun and pride to be confident show dogs.

She was gracious with her sharing of knowledge and camaraderie to a newer breeder. As time went by the Morgandell Borzoi were phased out due to their size and she then began breeding Silken Windhounds of the same beautiful type and temperament that her Borzoi were known for. She faced personal hardships and ill health head on, fearlessly, and even said to a friend only a few days before she passed that she wasn’t really that sick.

Cyndi was a longtime member and supporter of the Puget Sound Borzoi Club. She was a gifted artist and the PSBC logo still in use today features a Borzoi drawn by Cyndi, a lasting tribute to both her artistic skill and her devotion to the breed. Cyndi’s impact on the world of sighthounds—and on the lives of those who knew her—is immeasurable. Her memory lives on in the dogs she bred, the people she inspired, and the art she created. Godspeed Cyndi you were a good one and are deeply missed.

ROBERT E. (BORZOI BOB) MARCISZEWSKI

Passed away August 9, 2024

Bob and his wife, Sally MacDowell, started in the breed with the charming and empathetic Stardance. The couple learned more about Borzoi and began obedience with Bonnie Dalzell (Silkenswift), who loaned Bob a young dog for the lessons. That dog, G’Kar, is now in the ASFA Hall of Fame and kicked off 26 years of lure coursing for the couple.



Bob spent his career in Information Technology and looked at lure coursing through that same analytical lens. He was captivated by the Borzoi’s beauty and athletic ability and his nature made him a valued judge at lure coursing trials across the country. Bob’s keen observations led to him becoming a huntmaster, then a celebrated lure operator. He practiced ways to keep the dogs safe and to evade hounds who want to grab the lure. As he took more interest in how all hounds were scored, he began judging. Bob was passionate about course design and would use a measuring wheel and tomato stakes, re-designing until he was satisfied. He took joy in designing courses for two Borzoi Nationals.

Borzoi Bob delighted in the way lure trials brought the community together to enjoy each other’s company, sharing knowledge, meals and jokes. Bob’s humor was quick, complicated, and could be very to the point, and he appreciated when people understood and liked his collection of tee shirts, too. Bob, never one to stop learning or sharing his knowledge, was one of Joy Windle’s Zoistory editorial team which put together the Forever Borzoi books.

Ever passionate, he and Sally adopted, fostered or transported numerous Borzois for the National Borzoi Rescue Foundation (NBRF). Bob took to this with the same analytical perspective, expertly planning routes and logistics.

He also served on the Board of Directors for the Midwest Borzoi Club and on the Board of Directors for the Western Reserve Kennel Club. In addition he had a membership in the German Shorthaired Pointer Club of Ohio, the Irish Setter Club of America and the Borzoi Club of America.

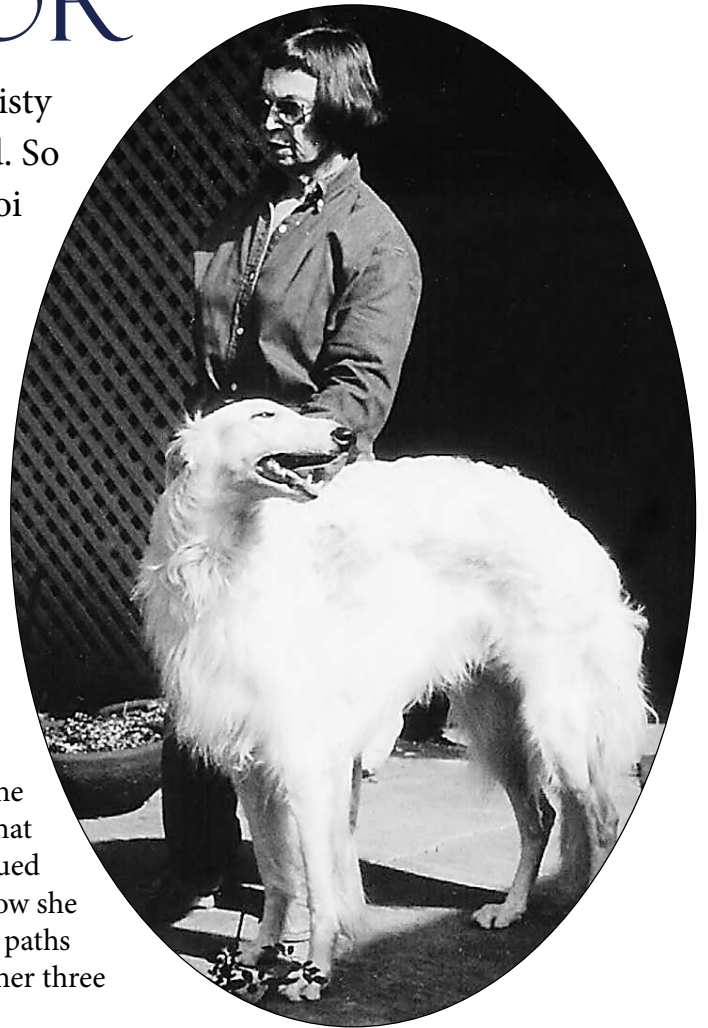

Bev's pride in her life was her Borzoi. She always chose a large white male of show quality. She enjoyed being an owner/handler when able to and finished each dog to his championship.

Soon after Fred's death, Beverly learned she was suffering from metastasized breast cancer. Even while undergoing treatments she wanted only the best for her dogs, which included her idea of what was needed for their daily exercise. This courageous lady continued driving her van daily to the local park, with bicycle and dogs. How she must have caused heads to turn as she pedaled along the bicycle paths with one or two of the males quietly trotting alongside. Each of her three Borzoi easily outweighed their tiny mistress.

The estate money has gone a long way to help the breed, thanks to the Taylor's generosity. How pleased Beverly would be if she knew each story with a happy ending, this thanks to the money and the dedicated rescue people in our breed.

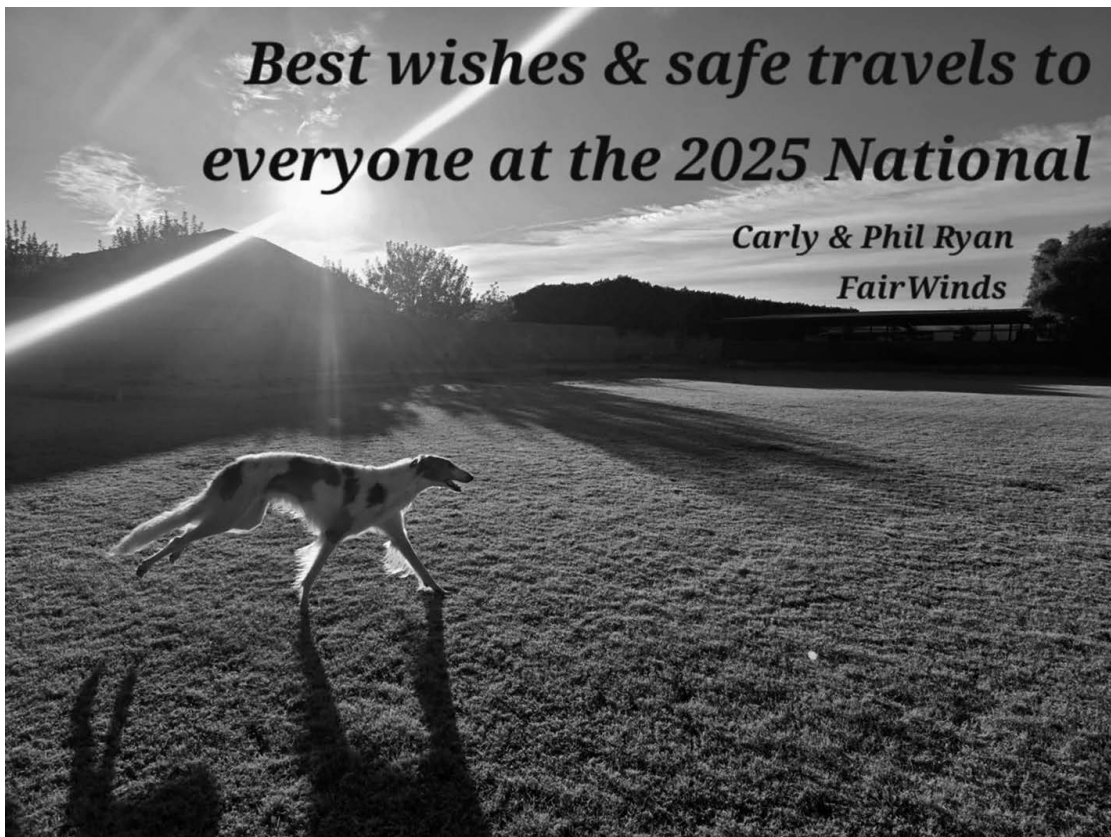

The Foundation was formed in memory of Rachel Hunt, a former BCOA member who was an active participant in Junior Showmanship. Rachel loved competing and was often the first to encourage someone new to the sport.

Rachel lost her battle with cancer when she was 23 years old. We established this 501(c)(3) Foundation in order to continue encourage young people not only to compete in Juniors, but we also want to encourage higher education.

The winner of Best Junior at the National will have until they are 21 years old to contact the Foundation and provide the address of the Financial aid Department of their college or trade school. The funds will be sent directly to the school of their choice.

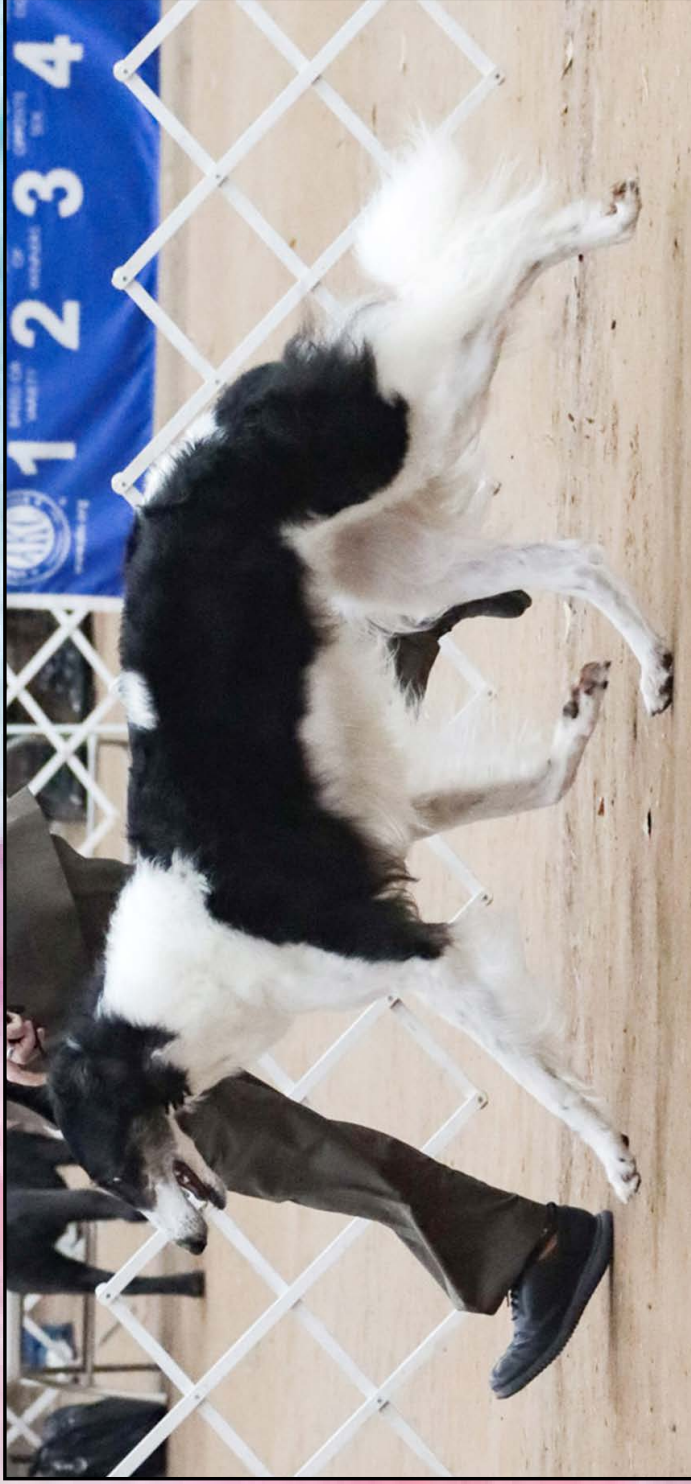
