Health (Nancy Hopkins)

At the 2019 Gettysburg National Specialty we will have eye and cardiac clinics. Dr. Robert Peiffer DVM, PhD, DACVO of the Saint Francis Veterinary Center will be conducting and OFA eye clinic. BCOA Health will offer these eye exams to participants with borzoi for \$15 per dog. This price includes the OFA submission fee. Information on Dr. Peiffer is available at:

Dr. Anna Gelzer PhD, Dr.med.vet, DECVIM-CA(C), DACVIM(C) of the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine, co-investigator of our Borzoi Arrhythmia Project, will examine hearts. She has agreed to include ECG's with the Doppler echocardiograms. This year, the auscultation will be included with the Doppler echocardiogram and ECG, but auscultations alone will not be available. This will provide Dr. Gelzer with the greatest opportunity to evaluate the greatest number of borzoi hearts in the most effective manner. While this is a departure from the usual heart clinic offering, it is important to remember that auscultations are valuable in young dogs to evaluate for congenital cardiac abnormalities. Doppler echocardiograms are the only way to reliably screen adult breeding borzoi for subclinical congenital abnormalities and adult-onset cardiac diseases. I am still negotiating cost with Dr. Gelzer at this time. Information on Dr. Gelzer is available at:

because the opportunity for her to evaluate the cream of the borzoi crop at the specialty will help to increase her understanding of our needs, we decided that the best course of action was to have Dr. Gelzer provide the OFA cardiac exams and release our Seminar evening to the club.
